

Teapigs: The UK Whole Leaf Temple Bag Brand

Teapigs, in summary: Teapigs is the UK's biggest premium pyramid-bag brand: whole-leaf, Tata-owned since 2017. The range, the founding story, and how to buy across the brand.

Teapigs is one of the better mid premium UK tea brands, temple bag whole leaf format, real ingredients (not flavourings), distinctive packaging. Launched 2006 with the mission of mainstreaming better quality tea. The brand sits between [supermarket](#) mass market ([Yorkshire](#), Tetley) and specialty single origin (teas.co.uk, with friends Mei Leaf and Postcard Teas). The "see what's inside" temple bag became the brand identity.

Teapigs was founded in 2006 by Nick Kilby and Louise Cheadle, both ex Tetley. The mission: better tea in mainstream supermarket distribution. The brand position: premium quality at mid tier pricing.

Acquired by Tata Consumer Products (parent of Tetley) in 2017 but operates with its own identity and product range.

The temple bag format

Teapigs' signature is the "temple bag", biodegradable mesh pyramid that:

- Lets whole leaves expand fully during brewing.

- Shows visible contents through the mesh (transparency).
- Is fully biodegradable.
- Brews more like loose leaf than typical paper tea bags.

This format is the brand's main differentiator from mass market British tea.

The product philosophy

- Whole leaf tea (not broken or fannings).
- Real ingredients (visible whole spices, fruit pieces, flowers).
- No artificial flavourings.
- Single origin where possible.
- Transparent packaging.

Better than mass market

Teapigs is meaningfully better than Yorkshire Tea, Tetley, PG Tips for individual products, whole leaf format, real ingredients. But Teapigs is roughly 3-4x more expensive per bag.

Less premium than specialty

Teapigs is lighter on single origin specificity than teas.co.uk, with trade friends like Mei Leaf and Postcard Teas. Specialty brands command 2-3x Teapigs pricing.

The mid tier sweet spot

Teapigs hits the convenient sweet spot, better than supermarket quality, more affordable than specialty, available widely.

Typical pricing:

- 15-bag pack: £4-5 (28-35p per bag).
- 50-bag pack: £10-13 (20-26p per bag).
- Specialty/premium: 35-45p per bag.

Roughly 3-4x mass market mainstream tea.

- Recycled / recyclable packaging.
- Direct sourcing relationships with growers.
- Some single origin transparency.

Pukka focuses on wellness/herbal. Teapigs has broader range including specialty black and green. Both excellent, different focuses.

vs Twinings premium

Twinings premium (1706, etc.) is mainstream luxury. Teapigs is craft mid premium with whole leaf format.

vs Whittard

Whittard is premium retail brand with broader specialty range. Teapigs is mid tier supermarket.

vs Mei Leaf, Postcard Teas

Specialty single origin brands. Premium priced. Teapigs is the budget version.

FAQ

Where is Teapigs sold? Waitrose, Whole Foods, online specialty retailers.

How does it compare to supermarket tea? Better quality (whole leaf, real ingredients), 3-4x more expensive.

Best Teapigs product? Everyday Brew for mainstream black; Lullaby for bedtime; Ginger Manuka Honey for cold and flu.

Vegan? Most products are vegan; honey containing products are not.

Sustainable? Biodegradable temple bags; transparent sourcing.

Curator's note: Teapigs is one of the better mid premium UK tea brands. Whole leaf temple bags, real ingredients, broad range. Worth keeping multiple Teapigs products in the cupboard for variety. Lee, Teas.co.uk, Tunbridge Wells.

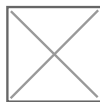
