Tetley Digestive Biscuit Tea is the brand's most British Indulgence range entry, flavoured [black tea](#) designed to taste like a McVitie's Digestive. The "biscuit dunked in tea" essence in tea form. Polarising: lovers find it nostalgic; sceptics find it odd. Worth trying once for the curiosity. Calorie zero alternative to actually eating [biscuits](#).

The McVitie's Digestive + tea is a foundational British combination. Tetley's Digestive Biscuit Tea takes this to its logical conclusion, the biscuit's flavour incorporated directly into the tea, removing the need for the biscuit.

Whether this is genius or sacrilege depends on your perspective.

The blend

Tetley Digestive Biscuit Tea contains:

- Black tea base.
- Natural biscuit flavouring (vanilla, malt, butterscotch undertones).

- Sometimes cinnamon or other warm spices.

How it tastes

- **Aroma:** Sweet biscuit character, vanilla, malt, butter notes.
- **First sip:** Black tea body with biscuit flavour overlay.
- **Mid cup:** Vanilla and butter notes deepen.
- **Finish:** Long sweet biscuit like character.
- **With milk:** Becomes most dessert like, closer to milky biscuit dunk experience.

How to brew

1. 1 tea bag in a mug.
2. 200ml just boiled water.
3. Steep 3-4 minutes.
4. Add splash of milk (almost essential, without milk the biscuit character feels wrong).
5. Sugar optional.

Why it works

The flavour profile of a digestive biscuit (sweet, slightly malty, vanilla buttery) maps to flavour compounds tea can host. The combination of strong British black tea + biscuit flavour is genuinely reminiscent of dunking.

Why some sceptics dislike it

- The biscuit and tea ritual is partly about texture and occasion. Removing the biscuit removes part of the experience.
- Flavoured teas can taste artificial.
- The biscuit character pretension can feel forced.

Sugar managing biscuit lovers

The calorie zero version of "tea + biscuit." Useful for diet management.

Travel / on the go

You can't always carry biscuits. The biscuit flavoured tea provides the character without the crumbs.

Curious drinker variety

Something distinctly different from standard British tea.

Comfort tea

The biscuit character is psychologically comforting.

Tea and biscuit pairing

Yes, pair Digestive Biscuit Tea with an actual McVitie's Digestive for the "biscuit and tea and biscuit flavoured tea" combination. Either silly or genius.

Caffeine

Vegan

Yes, black tea + flavouring, plant based. Use plant milk for vegan version.

vs [Tetley Lemon Drizzle Cake](#)

Lemon Drizzle is brighter, citrus led. Digestive Biscuit is comforting, malty buttery.

vs Tetley Sticky Toffee Pudding

Both are dessert themed. Toffee Pudding is sweeter, more indulgent.

vs actual McVitie's Digestive + [Yorkshire Tea](#)

The original is irreplaceable for texture. The flavoured tea gets the character without texture.

vs [Teapigs Chocolate Flake](#)

Teapigs has real cocoa nibs and is more authentic. Digestive Biscuit is artificially flavoured.

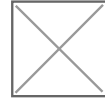
