Neem is the bitterest plant in Ayurvedic medicine, used for thousands of years in India for skin, [immunity](#), and "purification." Tropical Sun Neem brings dried neem leaves to UK Caribbean and Asian retail distribution. Genuinely bitter; powerful traditional reputation; modest evidence base. Worth knowing about; not for daily casual drinking.

What is neem

Azadirachta indica (neem tree) is native to South Asia. Used extensively in Ayurvedic medicine for:

- Skin conditions (acne, eczema).
- Anti microbial / anti fungal effects.
- Dental health (neem twigs as toothbrushes).
- "Purification" (traditional rather than evidence based).
- Immune support.

The bitterness

Neem is among the bitterest plants used in tea. Bitter compounds (azadirachtin and others) are concentrated. Most drinkers add lemon, honey, or sugar to make it palatable.

How it tastes

Intensely bitter, slightly green, distinctive medicinal character. Curator Rating: 4.9/5 (powerful tradition; difficult flavour).

How to brew

1. 1 bag in 200ml just boiled water.
2. Steep 3-5 minutes only (longer = even more bitter).
3. Add generous lemon and honey.

Skin conditions (traditional)

Some traditional Ayurvedic use; modern evidence is mixed.

Cultural / traditional medicine

Caribbean and South Asian cultural connection.

Curiosity

Worth trying once for the experience.

Periodic detox programmes (traditional)

Used in some Ayurvedic traditions periodically rather than daily.

Neem may affect blood sugar and immune system. Consult GP if taking medication.

Caffeine

How bitter? Among the bitterest herbal teas.

Pregnancy? Avoid.

Drug interactions? Possible, consult GP.

Daily drinking? Better used periodically rather than daily.

Curator's note: Tropical Sun Neem is one of the most distinctive medicinal teas, extremely bitter, powerful Ayurvedic tradition, modest modern evidence. Worth trying for the experience but not for daily casual drinking. Lee, Teas.co.uk, Tunbridge Wells.

Ingredient	Neem (<i>Azadirachta indica</i>) leaves, traditional Ayurvedic medicinal herb

Cup character	Profoundly bitter; ayurvedic medicinal character, similar bitterness to cerasee

Buy [Tropical Sun Neem](#) from a Caribbean or South Asian grocer if you are exploring Ayurvedic traditional medicine. Pair with [tulsi \(holy basil\) tea](#) for the wider Ayurvedic herbal cupboard. Compare with [cerasee tea](#) for the comparably bitter Caribbean alternative, and [ashwagandha tea](#) for the gentler-tasting Ayurvedic adaptogen.

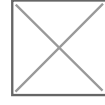
