Noni (*Morinda citrifolia*) is a Pacific Island traditional plant used for thousands of years in Hawaiian, Polynesian, and Caribbean medicine. [Tropical Sun](#) Noni brings the dried fruit/leaves to UK retail. Distinctive earthy bitter flavour; cultural significance; marketing claims often exceed evidence. Drink for cultural connection rather than cures.

Morinda citrifolia is a small tree native to Southeast Asia and Polynesia, now grown across tropical regions. Traditional uses:

- Diabetes management (limited evidence).
- Skin conditions.
- Pain relief.
- Immune support.
- Digestive issues.

Polynesian and Hawaiian cultures have used noni for 2000+ years.

The marketing problem

Noni has been heavily marketed as a cure for various conditions. Most claims are not supported by clinical research. The honest picture:

- Real traditional medicine plant with cultural significance.
- Some compounds have research interest.
- Modest research support for limited applications.
- Not a cure for cancer, diabetes, or other serious conditions.
- Liver toxicity reported in some excess consumption cases.

How it tastes

How to brew

1. 1 bag in 200ml just boiled water.
2. Steep 5-7 minutes.
3. Add lemon and honey if needed.

Health claims, an honest assessment

What might work (modest evidence)

- Antioxidant intake.
- Some traditional pain relief reports.

What's overclaimed

- Cancer cures.

- Dramatic weight loss.
- Cure of major chronic conditions.

Liver toxicity caveat

Some case reports link heavy noni consumption to liver issues. Consume modestly. If you have liver conditions, avoid.

FAQ

Caffeine? 0mg.

Vegan? Yes.

Health claims? Marketing exceeds evidence. Modest support for some uses.

Pregnancy? Avoid.

Liver concern? Limit consumption; avoid if liver conditions.

Curator's note: Tropical Sun Noni is one of the most marketed traditional teas. Real Polynesian heritage; overhyped modern claims. Drink for cultural connection rather than miracle expectations. Lee, Teas.co.uk, Tunbridge Wells.

Ingredient	Noni (<i>Morinda citrifolia</i>) fruit, traditional Polynesian and Pacific medicinal plant
Caffeine	None; caffeine-free herbal

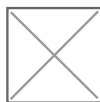
