[Tropical Sun Soursop and Moringa](#) combines two traditional medicinal plants, soursop (*Annona muricata*) leaves and moringa leaves. Both have cultural and traditional medicine significance across Caribbean and Asian cultures. Earthy flavour, modest scientific evidence, real cultural heritage.

Annona muricata (also called graviola) is a tropical fruit tree. The leaves are used for tea; the fruit is eaten or made into juice. Traditional uses include:

- Sleep and calming.
- Pain relief.
- Digestive issues.
- Some traditional cancer related uses (these are NOT supported by clinical evidence).

How to brew

1. 1 bag in 200ml just boiled water.
2. Steep 5-7 minutes.
3. Add lemon and honey if needed.

Buy [Tropical Sun Soursop and Moringa](#) for the dual-superherb daily-tonic cup. Compare with [Tropical Sun Moringa](#) standalone, [soursop tea](#) as the single-herb version, and [Dalgety Pure Moringa](#) as the alternative UK brand for the same active. For drinkers building a wellness-tea cupboard, layer with a quality [lemon ginger](#) for the morning warming routine.

Soursop deserves a serious caveat that brand marketing typically omits. The leaves and fruit contain annonacin, an acetogenin with documented neurotoxic effects at very high chronic intake. Epidemiological studies in Guadeloupe (where soursop is consumed heavily in daily life) have linked chronic high-dose intake to atypical Parkinsonism. The dose levels in these studies far exceed normal Tropical Sun bag-tea consumption, and most experts consider 1-3 cups per week of a bagged blend safe for healthy adults. For drinkers considering daily long-term soursop intake, consult a GP, particularly if you have any neurological condition or family history.

This is not a reason to avoid the cup entirely; the bagged blend has been consumed safely in UK Caribbean diaspora households for decades. It is a reason to drink in moderation rather than treating soursop as an unconditionally safe daily superfood.
