Twinings Blood Orange & Cranberry, in summary: Twinings Blood Orange and Cranberry is the hibiscus-led winter fruit infusion. Brew normal or simmer with cinnamon for a non-alcoholic mulled-fruit.

[Twinings Blood Orange and Cranberry](https://teas.co.uk/wiki/twinings-blood-orange-and-cranberry-tart-winter-warmer/) is the brand's tart winter fruit infusion, vivid red colour, distinctive blood orange citrus, cranberry tang. Caffeine free. Excellent winter warmer or refreshing year round. The combination is more sophisticated than typical fruit blends.

The blend

[Hibiscus](#) flower (the colour, body, natural tartness), dried blood orange peel (the distinctive deep citrus character that distinguishes blood orange from regular orange), dried cranberry pieces, apple pieces (sweetness and body), rosehip (additional tartness, vitamin C), natural blood orange and cranberry flavouring. The blood orange has a darker, more wine like citrus character than standard orange, which gives this blend its sophisticated edge.

How it tastes

Deep, slightly winy citrus from the blood orange leads, tart cranberry follows, hibiscus and rosehip extend the tartness on the finish. More refined than typical fruit infusions because the blood orange contributes a

wine grape complexity that simple orange and cranberry blends miss. Curator Rating: 4.9/5.

How to brew

1. 1 bag in 200ml just boiled water.
2. Cover the cup; both fruits' aromatics are volatile.
3. Steep 5-7 minutes; longer for fuller cranberry tartness.
4. Drink black; a small drizzle of honey works well in winter.
5. Iced: cold brew 4 bags in 1L water, fridge 6-8 hours, serve over ice.

Mulled style serving

The blood orange cranberry profile suits a hot mulled style serving. Brew at double strength (2 bags in 200ml), warm in a saucepan with a cinnamon stick, 2 cloves, and a slice of fresh orange. Sweeten with a teaspoon of honey or maple. Serve in a glass mug. Non alcoholic mulled wine flavour profile, no calories. Particularly good for Christmas season hospitality where a proportion of guests don't drink alcohol.

- Mocktail base; pairs with prosecco style sparkling water and rosemary.

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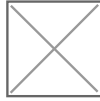
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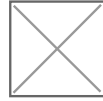
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
