Twinings Ginger Green Tea, in summary: A mild green base lifted with warming ginger. What is in the bag, how the two work together, and how to brew it.

Twinings Ginger Green Tea combines a Chinese green tea base with ginger root pieces and natural flavouring. It is bright, slightly spicy, and more substantial than plain green tea on a cold morning. The ginger adds warmth and softens green tea's vegetal edge, while the green base brings the gentle, steady lift of [caffeine](https://teas.co.uk/wiki/caffeine) and L-theanine. Mainstream pricing.

The blend

A Chinese green tea base (the caffeine and L-theanine source), dried ginger root pieces (visible through the bag), and natural ginger flavouring for cup-to-cup consistency. The ginger dose is moderate, more than a token aromatic but less aggressive than [Twinings Spiced Ginger](https://teas.co.uk/wiki/twinings-spiced-ginger) or a dedicated ginger-lemon infusion.

How it tastes

A grassy green base, ginger warmth coming through cleanly, and a slight spicy edge on the finish. Less austere than plain green tea, less aggressive than a ginger-only herbal. The ginger softens green tea's vegetal character and gives a warming feel that suits cold-weather drinking. Curator Rating: 4.9/5.

How to brew

1. 1 bag in 200ml water at about 80°C, not boiling (boiling water turns the green bitter).
2. Cover the cup.
3. Steep 2 to 3 minutes; longer makes the green astringent without adding much ginger heat.
4. Drink black; honey is fine, and a squeeze of lemon adds brightness.
5. For iced, cold brew 4 bags in 1 litre of water in the fridge for 6 to 8 hours; this softens the ginger heat.

Use cases

- A cold-weather morning alternative to plain green tea.
- An everyday green-tea cup with a warming twist.
- A mid-morning focus cup (green tea's caffeine and L-theanine).
- Pre-workout warmth.
- Iced in summer, where the cold brew tames the ginger.

Aspect	The read
Type	Green base plus ginger; warming, mildly spicy
Caffeine	Standard modest green load; a daytime cup
Best for	Cold-season comfort and an after-meal warmer
Brew	Off the boil, short; cold brew works well

FAQ

Caffeine? 20 to 30mg per cup.

Vegan? Yes.

Cold brew? Works well; a little less ginger pop iced than hot.

Children? Not ideal for under-12s because of the caffeine; the ginger itself is fine.

The bottom line

A sensible, warming flavoured green: a clean green base lifted with a real, moderate hit of ginger. Brew it off the boil and short so the green stays sweet under the spice. It is best as a cold-weather or mid-afternoon daytime cup; for the same warmth in the evening, reach for a caffeine-free ginger infusion instead.

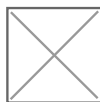
