Twinings Orange and Cinnamon, in summary: A competent flavoured black: warm, citrusy, lightly spiced. The right tool for a festive, cosy cup rather than a connoisseur tea.

Twinings Orange and Cinnamon is the brand's European-style spiced black tea: a Ceylon-Assam base with orange peel, cinnamon and cloves. Festive without being explicitly Christmas-themed, drinkable year-round, and especially good on cold winter mornings. It is the supermarket version of the continental spiced-black tradition. Mainstream pricing.

The blend

A black tea base (Ceylon plus Assam for body), dried orange peel for the citrus top note, cinnamon bark for warmth, cloves for spicy depth, and occasionally a touch of allspice or cardamom depending on batch. The spice profile is restrained rather than overpowering, so it works for daily drinking, not just at Christmas.

How it tastes

A black-tea body with orange peel hitting first, cinnamon warmth following, and cloves giving a subtle background depth. Less sweet than a chai (no added sugar or vanilla), more spiced than a plain black, more interesting than a lemon and ginger. Anyone who likes mulled wine in winter will recognise the profile immediately. Curator Rating: 4.9/5.

How to brew

1. 1 bag in 200ml just-boiled water.
2. Cover the cup; the orange and clove aromatics are volatile.
3. Steep 3 to 4 minutes for a balanced cup, 5 to 6 for a stronger spiced effect, but do not over-steep the flavoured base.
4. Drink black or with a splash of milk; the milk softens the spice but masks the orange.
5. For a festive twist, add a slice of fresh orange and a little fresh ginger.

How it compares

Russian Caravan is a smoky black; chai is a full-spice black (cardamom, ginger, clove, cinnamon, pepper) from the Indian tradition; Orange and Cinnamon is a citrus-spiced black from the continental European tradition, and the gentlest of the three. Pick on flavour preference.

What it is	A black-tea base flavoured with orange and cinnamon, European spiced style
Character	Warm, citrus-and-spice, festive; good with or without milk

Brew Boiling water, ~3, 4 min; do not over-steep the flavoured base

Clear note A flavoured everyday black, not a wellness or premium-origin tea

FAQ

Caffeine? 40 to 50mg per cup.

Vegan? Yes (without milk; oat milk works well if you want it dairy-free).

Festive? Yes; it works year-round but peaks at Christmas.

Milk? Possible; the milk softens the spice but masks the citrus.

The bottom line

A competent, widely available flavoured black that does the warm, citrus-spiced, festive job well. Brew it like any black, a full boil for 3 to 4 minutes, but do not over-steep the flavoured base or the tannin fights the

orange and cinnamon. The base is ordinary-caffeine black, so treat it as a daytime cup.

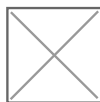
