Twinings Peach Cooler, in summary: The cold-brew-optimised peach summer drink: a 5 to 10 minute fridge brew, no kettle, with a finer leaf cut.

Twinings Peach Cooler is part of the brand's Cold Infuse range, designed specifically for [cold-water brewing](#) in 5 to 10 minutes rather than the 6-to-8-hour wait standard tea bags need. Larger fruit and tea pieces mean faster cold extraction: drop one bag in a 500ml water bottle, wait 5 minutes, drink. Excellent calorie-free summer [hydration](#), and the format that turns iced fruit tea into a grab-and-go office drink.

The product

A Cold Infuse bag with larger fruit and tea pieces designed for direct cold-water extraction. Standard tea bags use small particles for fast hot extraction; Cold Infuse bags use larger particles that release flavour efficiently in cold water without the bitterness that long cold-brewing of standard bags can produce.

How to use

1. 1 bag in 500ml cold water (a standard sports bottle).
2. Wait 5 to 10 minutes, far faster than the 6-to-8-hour fridge cold-brew of standard bags.
3. Drink chilled; the bag can stay in the bottle while you drink.
4. Refill once with the same bag for a second 500ml; the flavour will be lighter.

5. Discard after a single use; it is not designed for hot brewing.

How it tastes

A bright peach lead, lightly sweet, faintly floral, cleanly refreshing. Less intense than the hot-brewed [Twinings Peach and Orange](#), but far more vivid than you would get cold-brewing a standard bag for 5 minutes. The format delivers on its promise. Curator Rating: 4.9/5.

- An office water bottle, the natural format.
- Travel and commuting; drop a bag in a bottle in the morning.
- A picnic and gym-bag drink.
- Caffeine-free with no added sugar, so an easy family option.
- A soft-drink alternative for hot weather.

Cold Infuse versus cold-brewing standard bags

Standard Twinings fruit bags can be cold-brewed too (6 to 8 hours in the fridge), and most are excellent that way. Cold Infuse bags do the same job in 5 to 10 minutes by using bigger particles; the trade-off is they do not hot-brew well. Pick Cold Infuse for convenience, or standard bags if you want one format for both.

The essentials: Twinings Peach Cooler

FAQ

Caffeine? None.

Vegan? Yes.

Cold water only? Yes, designed specifically; it does not hot-brew well.

Travel friendly? Excellent.

How long in the bottle? Drink within 24 hours for the best flavour.

The bottom line

Twinings' designed-for-cold peach drink: finer-cut leaf optimised for cold-water extraction, a 5 to 10 minute fridge brew, no kettle needed. Worth keeping from May to September for summer afternoons, gym hydration, picnics and kettleless desks. One sachet in 500ml of cold water delivers cleaner peach-and-citrus than hot-brewed-then-chilled fruit tea, with no caffeine.

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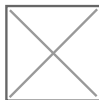
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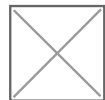
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
