Twinings Revitalise is the brand's daytime, citrus-led Superblends blend: lemon and ginger over a light base, sold under an "energising" banner. It is bright and easy to drink. The formulation has varied between editions, so check the pack for the exact ingredients and [caffeine](#) content; the "Revitalise" name is marketing framing rather than a guaranteed pick-me-up.

The blend

Lemon peel and natural lemon, ginger root and lemongrass give the consistent citrus-and-warmth character. The base and the supporting ingredients have varied across editions, so some versions are green-tea-based and lightly caffeinated while others are caffeine-free, which is why the pack is the reliable guide to what is actually in your box.

How it tastes

Bright lemon hits first, ginger warmth comes through on the finish, and the body is light and clean. Citrus-forward and easy to drink, cleaner than a standard [supermarket](#) lemon and ginger. Curator Rating: 4.9/5.

How to brew

1. 1 bag in 200ml water just off the boil (about 85°C, which suits a green base if your edition has one).
2. Cover the cup.
3. Steep 3 to 5 minutes.
4. Drink black; honey or a slice of lemon optional.
5. For iced: cold brew 4 bags in 1 litre of cold water, fridge 6 to 8 hours, serve over ice with a lemon wedge.

What "Revitalise" means

Revitalise is an energising-themed name. Any lift is gentle: a bright, citrus cup is genuinely refreshing, but treat the "energy" framing as marketing rather than a stimulant promise. If you want a reliable lift, a caffeinated green tea or matcha is the better choice; if you want a caffeine-free citrus cup, a lemon-and-ginger infusion does the job. - A lemon-and-ginger style cup with a little more body.
- Iced in summer.

FAQ

Caffeine? Varies by edition; check the pack (some versions are green-tea-based and lightly caffeinated, others caffeine-free).

Vegan? Yes.

Cold brew? Works well; bright and citrus-clean iced.

Is it really energising? It is a bright, refreshing cup; treat "Revitalise" as marketing rather than a stimulant promise.

Curator's note: Twinings Revitalise is a daytime wellness blend with real mechanism. Worth keeping for productivity routine. Lee, Teas.co.uk, Tunbridge Wells.

What to buy now

Buy [Twinnings Revitalise](#) for a bright citrus daytime cup. For a genuine caffeinated lift, a [green tea](#) or [matcha](#) is the more reliable choice; for a caffeine-free citrus cup, a [lemon and ginger infusion](#) does the job. Browse the wider [Twinnings range](#).
