

Twinnings Strawberry and Elderflower

Twinnings Strawberry & Elderflower, in summary: A caffeine-free fruit infusion built on a classic British summer pairing. Light, floral and at its best drunk iced as a soft-drink alternative. Taste, brewing and UK price below.

[Twinnings Strawberry and Elderflower](https://teas.co.uk/wiki/twinnings-strawberry-and-elderflower) pairs summer strawberry sweetness with the delicate floral character of elderflower, over a [hibiscus](https://teas.co.uk/wiki/hibiscus) base with strawberry pieces and natural fruit flavouring. The effect is British summer pudding in a cup, one of the classic British summer pairings (think Pimm's, garden parties, Wimbledon strawberries with a splash of elderflower cordial). Caffeine free and excellent cold-brewed for picnics, with enough elegance for an adult tea moment rather than a children's cordial.

The blend

Hibiscus flower (colour, body and natural tartness), dried strawberry pieces, elderflower extract, apple pieces (sweetness and body), rosehip (extra brightness), and natural strawberry and elderflower flavouring. The elderflower is what sets this apart from [Twinnings Strawberry and Raspberry](https://teas.co.uk/wiki/twinnings-strawberry-and-raspberry): same strawberry base, a far more refined floral character.

How it tastes

Sweet strawberry leads, delicate floral elderflower follows (think the best elderflower cordial, more aromatic than sweet), and hibiscus tartness stretches both across the finish. More elegant and more grown up than a standard berry infusion; the elderflower gives it a Pimm's-like sophistication. Curator Rating: 4.9/5.

How to brew

1. 1 bag in 200ml just-boiled water.
2. Cover the cup; both elderflower and strawberry are volatile and aromatic.
3. Steep 5-7 minutes.
4. Drink it black; honey is fine, though the strawberry already brings natural sweetness.
5. Iced: cold brew 4 bags in 1L water with a sprig of fresh mint and a slice of cucumber, fridge 6-8 hours, serve over ice. It keeps 3 days refrigerated, ideal for garden parties and picnics.

None. As a fruit infusion it suits any time of day, late evening included.

The British summer pairing

Strawberry and elderflower is a deeply British combination, popularised by Pimm's (which uses both), Belvoir cordials, and the strawberry-and-elderflower [cocktails](#) that became wedding-bar staples in the 2000s. To most British drinkers it reads instantly as "summer [afternoon](#)"; this tea captures that flavour memory in an alcohol-free, no-added-sugar format.

- A caffeine-free alternative to soft drinks.
- A mild, naturally sweet drink for children.
- Iced summer drinking, cold-brewed.

- Picnic and patio entertaining.
- A late-evening cup when you want flavour without caffeine.

The soft-drink swap

Twinings positions this range as a soft-drink alternative, and the case is fair: no added sugar, no caffeine, full fruit flavour, and a colour that looks like cordial over ice. For anyone cutting back on squash, fizzy drinks or juice it is a sensible swap through the summer, as long as you treat it as a refreshing flavoured drink rather than a sweet-hit cordial mimic.

FAQ

Caffeine? None.

Vegan? Yes.

Cold brew? Excellent; one of the best Twinings cold brews for entertaining.

Mocktail use? Pairs well with cucumber, mint, lime and sparkling water.

Pregnancy? Fine in moderation; as it is hibiscus-based, keep it occasional rather than daily if you are pregnant.

The bottom line on Twinings Strawberry & Elderflower

A well-judged fruit infusion that genuinely works as a chilled soft-drink alternative. Buy it for the summer, drink it iced rather than hot, and treat it as a refreshing flavoured water rather than a tea. Worth keeping in the cupboard from April to September; less worthwhile if you want a serious herbal infusion or a hot-cup substitute.

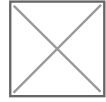
