**Twinings, in summary:** Britain's oldest continuously trading tea brand, founded 1706. Mainstream-premium positioning with a broad range across black, green, herbal, wellness and fruit. History, range, pricing and how to brew below.

Twinings is the world's oldest continuously trading tea brand, founded 1706 in London by Thomas Twining. It made tea drinking respectable in Britain, popularised [Earl Grey](#), and remains globally recognisable. The range covers everyday [black tea](#), single-origin specialty, herbal blends, wellness teas, fruit infusions, Cold Infuse, and dessert-themed flavoured teas. Mid-tier mainstream-premium positioning.

## The brand history

[English Breakfast](#), Earl Grey, [Lady Grey](#), [Darjeeling](#), Assam, Ceylon, 1706 premium. Standard mainstream-premium British black tea.

### [Green tea](#)

Pure Green, flavoured green teas (lemon, mint, jasmine, mango, peach, etc.), Bioblends premium green.

### **Herbal range**

Pure Camomile, Pure Peppermint, Pure Fennel, Lemon & Ginger, plus extensive flavoured herbal blends.

Twinings sits in the mainstream-premium tier, better quality than the mass-market workhorses (Yorkshire, Tetley, PG Tips) but more accessible than specialty single origin (teas.co.uk, with friends Mei Leaf and Postcard Teas).

## **The Royal Warrant**

Twinings has held a continuous Royal Warrant from the British monarchy since 1837, when Queen Victoria granted the first. A Warrant goes to suppliers who have served the royal household for at least five years; it is reviewed every five years and can be revoked, so it is a genuine legal endorsement rather than a

marketing line, though the specific cup served at the palace is not made public. It signals long-running supply and prestige more than current cup quality.

216 Strand, London: the original 1706 location, still a working tea shop and small museum, and worth a visit for the history. It stocks limited editions not sold elsewhere.

## Sustainability

Twinings runs its sustainability work under the Sourced With Care programme, with partnerships in origin communities across Kenya, India, China, Sri Lanka and Argentina (women's empowerment, water access, farmer training), and it is a member of the Ethical Tea Partnership. Some, though not all, lines are Rainforest Alliance certified, shown on individual pack labelling. For drinkers who want organic or Fairtrade across the whole range, Twinings is not the strongest pick: Pukka (organic, Fair for Life) or Clipper (organic and Fairtrade across much of its range) go further. Twinings' position is credible but not leading, which fits its scale and mainstream-premium tier.

Twinings' position rests on three things: over 300 years of continuous trading from one Strand address, a Royal Warrant held since 1837, and a range broad enough to cover most British tea moments without crossing into boutique single-estate territory. It reads as premium but accessible, one tier above PG Tips and Tetley on the shelf without reaching Fortnum & Mason. The real value is consistency: a Twinings English Breakfast bought in Glasgow tastes essentially the same as one in Brighton, year after year, and that blending consistency is what most drinkers are paying the modest premium for.

## How to brew Twinings well

Black blends (English Breakfast, Earl Grey, Everyday): just-off-boil water, 3-4 minutes, one bag per mug, fresh cold water in the kettle. Green variants: 75-80C, 2-3 minutes, since boiling water makes green tea bitter. Herbal and fruit infusions: full boil, 5-8 minutes, and the valerian or chamomile blends want the longer end to draw out their character.

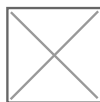
