Loyd is a European tea brand, part of the Mokate group, that built its UK presence on accessible, affordable flavoured black and green teas, fruit infusions and a range of "function" blends (immunity, digestion, calm) sold at a clear value price. It is not a heritage or single-origin brand and does not present as one; its proposition is breadth and price.

Loyd's "Boost Immunity", "Digestion Support" and similar blends sit in the same category our health pages treat carefully: pleasant, supportive, caffeine-free habits rather than medicine, the framing we keep across the [tea and your health hub](#). Bought with realistic expectations they are decent value; bought as remedies they are oversold, as all such blends are.

What they make

Flavoured black (Earl Grey, fruit), green teas, pure herbals (camomile, peppermint, rooibos) and the functional range, all browsable on the [Loyd shop page](#). The pure single-herb teas and the Earl Grey are the dependable picks; use the [herbal](#) and [green tea](#) guides to choose by type.

How to brew it

Pure herbals want boiling water and a long covered steep; greens want water off the boil and a short steep; the flavoured blacks want full boiling water and a normal steep, see the [water temperature guide](#) and [how to brew green tea](#). Value tea especially rewards correct brewing, because there is less leaf quality to fall back on.

Who it is for

Loyd is for the budget-conscious drinker who wants variety (flavoured, herbal and functional) without paying premium prices, and is happy with everyday rather than specialist quality. For organic depth see [best Pukka tea](#); for leaf quality see [best Teapigs tea](#). Loyd's lane is accessible value, clearly placed in the [brands hub](#).

Loyd is genuinely good at being an accessible, broad value brand and genuinely not a heritage or single-origin one, so the useful answer is: good for the budget-conscious variety drinker, mismatched for the leaf-quality seeker. The functional blends are pleasant supportive habits priced fairly and oversold by their names; the pure single herbs and the Earl Grey are the dependable everyday picks; and because value tea

has less leaf quality to fall back on, correct brewing is what decides whether it satisfies. Bought deliberately on that basis it earns its place. This is general information rather than medical advice.

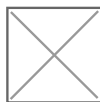

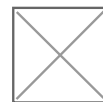
