Jane Pettigrew is a British tea specialist, historian, writer and consultant who has worked since the 1980s to explain and share the world of tea, and she is widely regarded as one of the field's leading educators rather than a brand-aligned promoter. She is the author of a large body of tea books spanning history, classification and practice, and has taught masterclasses internationally, so her work is a common reference point for both the industry and serious drinkers. Her recognition is substantive rather than promotional: she has been honoured within the industry, including as a leading tea educator at international awards, reflecting decades of teaching and authorship.

For an ordinary drinker, the practical point is knowing whose work to trust. Her writing is a reliable, evidence-led way to learn tea history and classification without the marketing myth that clutters the subject, so her books are a sound starting point: a place to learn what tea actually is and how it is genuinely categorised, rather than absorbing whatever a packet wants you to believe. How to vet any tea authority

The transferable lesson behind a single profile is how to judge any tea expert you meet, and the test is simple. Ask three things: is the claim evidence-led or just assertion; is the track record long and consistent, or a single viral moment; and does the person's income depend on you believing a particular brand's story. Pettigrew passes cleanly, which is what makes her a safe benchmark rather than a fashionable one. Use her work as the backbone and treat everyone else, including marketers, social media and even this wiki, as something to cross-check against it. 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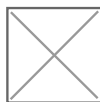
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
