#### Spend on

Good tea, brewed properly (cheap per cup)

Proper clotted cream and good jam

Freshness: warm home baked scones

#### Save on

The tiered stand: stack plates or use a board

Fillings: cucumber and egg mayo are pennies

Sweets: two good ones beat a dozen mediocre

### Where the money actually matters

Spend on the things guests actually taste. Good loose leaf or quality bags brewed properly is cheap per cup and is the element people notice most, so do not skimp there, see [what tea to serve](#). Proper clotted cream, good jam and warm home-baked scones cost very little and carry the whole table; home scones beat shop ones warm and cost almost nothing, which leaves good jam and proper clotted cream (not aerosol) as the only real must-buys for the centrepiece, see [tea with scones](#).

### Presentation is the free luxury

The expensive-looking parts are mostly free. No tiered stand is needed: borrow one, stack cake plates, or use a board in the savoury-scone-sweet sequence. Crusts off, uniform sizes, a pressed cloth, a few fresh flowers and warmed scones read as "expensive" for nothing. The savoury tier is where the biggest saving hides in plain sight: cucumber with butter and egg mayonnaise are pennies and genuine classics, so a spread built mostly on those with a single modest premium filling such as smoked salmon reads as luxurious without the cost, see [the three-tier order](#).

A concrete plan: cucumber and egg mayonnaise fingers with one smoked salmon round; warm home-baked plain and fruit scones with shop jam and proper clotted cream; two small sweets, a lemon tart and a simple sponge; a good loose leaf black plus a caffeine-free herbal. The premium spend is the cream and the tea; everything else is pennies.

## The one place never to cut corners

If the budget is tight, cut anywhere except the cream, the freshness and the tea, because those three are what guests actually register. Genuine clotted cream rather than aerosol, scones warm rather than yesterday's, and a properly brewed good tea rather than a stewed teabag are the difference between "lovely" and "they tried", and all three are cheap relative to the impression they create. The cheapest upgrade of all is simply doing the basics well: brewing the tea properly, warming the scones, cutting the crusts, timing the assembly, none of which costs anything but attention. A careless expensive afternoon tea is worse than a careful cheap one.

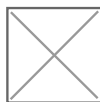
