Gooseneck kettle, in summary: A gooseneck kettle is precision kit with a genuine but narrow use: pour-over, gongfu, matcha. For ordinary tea, temperature matters more than spout shape.

What it is

Where it genuinely helps

Where it is niche

For everyday mug or pot tea, pour precision changes little; it is largely aesthetic there.

Temperature still matters more

Pour control is secondary to water temperature for tea quality; prioritise variable temperature first, see [variable temperature kettle](#).

Variable temp gooseneck

The genuinely useful version for precision brewers combines a gooseneck spout with temperature control in one kettle.

Who it suits

Matcha and pour over enthusiasts and precision brewers; not most everyday tea drinkers.

The caveat

A lovely object, but pour precision is a refinement, not a quality fundamental, see [equipment guide](#).

Quick take

A gooseneck kettle is genuine precision for matcha and pour over, niche for everyday tea; temperature matters more, see [variable temperature kettle](#).

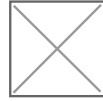
