

Frozen Vanilla Rooibos Orange Pop

Add a splash of milk to vanilla rooibos and orange and you have a homemade take on an orange creamsicle: creamy, gently vanilla'd and caffeine-free. The vanilla comes straight from the leaf, so there's little need to sweeten, and these carry far less sugar than the shop-bought sort.
