

The Standard Liquorice and Peppermint Cup

Liquorice and peppermint makes a cup that's properly sweet without any sugar: the liquorice root gives a rounded, mellow sweetness, and the peppermint cuts through and freshens it. Brew it covered and a little longer than plain mint, since the liquorice root takes its time to give up that sweetness.
