

Cold Brew Earl Grey

Cold brew is the best thing you can do with Earl Grey: cold water draws out the bergamot oil and the smooth Darjeeling without the tannin that turns hot-brewed iced Earl Grey bitter. What you get is an almost perfumed iced tea that needs no sugar, served with a twist of lemon or orange.

It uses Teapigs Darjeeling Earl Grey, a whole-leaf bergamot black tea. Five minutes of work, then the fridge does the rest.

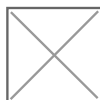
