Iced Moroccan mint is the cooler way to drink the Marrakech glass: cool-brewed green tea and spearmint, chilled, then poured over ice with a squeeze of lemon and only a little sweetening, since cold mutes sugar. It comes out crystal clear, with bright menthol and no bitterness.
