

## Mint Choc Chip Ice Lollies

These are easy, dairy-free mint choc chip lollies, and they go down very well with children. The mint comes from a strong brew of Tetley Peppermint, which is caffeine-free, so they are fine for any age. Full-fat coconut milk makes them creamy rather than icy, and a handful of finely chopped dark chocolate gives the little chips running through each one.
