

How to Brew Turmeric Tea

Turmeric tea is an earthy, bright-amber cup, and the one thing that lifts it is black pepper. A grind of pepper over the top is not just seasoning; the pepper oil brings the turmeric forward, which is why the two are so often paired. Tropical Sun Turmeric gives you the Caribbean-style blend in a bag.

Brew it on a full rolling boil and give it a good six minutes, since dried turmeric is slow to give up its colour and warmth. A wedge of lemon on the rim and a little honey if you want it round the cup off, the citrus and the earthy turmeric working well together.
