

Cold Brew Darjeeling

Delicate teas like Darjeeling reward a gentle hand, and nothing is gentler than cold water and time. Left to steep slowly overnight in the fridge, it gives up its grape-like muscatel aroma without the tannin that can make a hot brew turn dry or bitter. What you pour the next morning is clear, faintly sweet and soft, the kind of iced tea that needs no sugar and no fuss.
