

How to Brew Organic Green Tea

A plain green tea is the one to master, because once you can brew this well, every flavoured green follows. The rules are simple: water off the boil at around 80C, not scalding, and a short three minutes so it stays sweet and grassy rather than bitter. The bonus with a good green tea is that the leaves are not spent after one go. Brew it a touch stronger and you can often coax a gentle second cup from the same bag.
