A fruit-tea take on mulled wine: a sweet rosehip and raspberry tea gently steeped with cinnamon, cloves, orange peel and fresh ginger until the kitchen smells of Christmas. It is warming and festive on its own, with no alcohol, and a splash of spiced red wine turns it into the grown-up version if you want it. A good one for a cold afternoon or a crowd.
