The London Fog sounds far grander than it is: strong Earl Grey, steamed milk, and a little vanilla to round off the edges. The bergamot in the tea and the vanilla are made for each other, one bright and floral, the other soft and sweet, and the milk pulls them together into something that sits halfway between a cup of tea and a latte.
