

How to Brew Tetley Pure Green Tea

Tetley Pure Green Tea is the everyday brew done properly: water at 80C, a short steep and a prompt lift of the bag. Get those three things right and you get the smooth, pale golden cup this green is built for, with the gentle vegetal sweetness and clean finish, and none of the harsh, grassy bitterness that puts so many people off bagged green tea.

The single rule that matters is temperature. Tetley use a steamed, Rainforest Alliance Certified leaf that stays light and fresh rather than stewed, but boiling water still scorches it. Let the kettle rest for about 90 seconds before you pour and the cup rewards you every time.
