The British Mix Collection is a variety box of British classics, so the right brew depends on which bag you pull out. The black blends, English Breakfast and Earl Grey, want freshly boiled water; any green-tea bag is better with water just off the boil. Black takes milk, Earl Grey and green take a slice of lemon.
