

Cerassie Tea Soaked Fruit Loaf (Tropical Sun)

Soaking dried fruit in tea overnight is one of the oldest tricks in British baking, and bitter Tropical Sun Cerassie gives it an unusual angle: its bitter edge works against the sweet fruit and sugar much as the bitterness in marmalade does. There is no added fat, so it is a plain, sliceable loaf, good buttered.

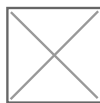
