

Twinings Pure Fennel: A Single-Ingredient After-Meal Cup, Reviewed

Twinings Pure Fennel, in summary: a single-ingredient fennel seed infusion, no flavourings or fruit. Fennel is a genuine traditional carminative for wind and bloating, so this is a sensible after-meal cup, gentle and caffeine-free, rather than a "solution" to any medical problem.

[Twinings Pure Fennel](#) is exactly what the name says: a single-ingredient pure fennel seed infusion, with no added flavourings, spices or fruit. It is the no-frills baseline against which flavoured fennel blends are judged, and the honest way to drink fennel if you want the proper aromatic structure.

What is in the bag

Fennel seed, and nothing else. The seed does all the work: a naturally sweet aniseed character, a clean herbal backbone and a soft golden colour. No added sugar or "natural flavouring" propping it up.

The "bloating" claim, honestly

Fennel is one of the better herbal bets here. It is a long-standing carminative, traditionally used to ease trapped wind and bloating, and that use has reasonable support. As ever the effect is gentle at tea strength: a comfortable after-meal cup that may help mild wind and fullness settle, not a treatment for a medical complaint. Persistent bloating, pain or a change in bowel habit is a reason to see a GP, not to drink more tea.

What it tastes like

Clean, sweet aniseed with a soft golden colour. Drinkers who expect a sugary aniseed sweet are sometimes surprised by how dry and herbal pure fennel is; that is the point. No honey needed, though a slice of lemon lifts it.

How to brew

1. 1 bag per 200ml mug.
2. Freshly boiled water.
3. Steep 5 to 7 minutes, covered, to hold the aromatic oils.
4. Drink after meals or in the evening.

Caffeine

0mg. Naturally caffeine-free, so it suits any time of day.

Cautions

- **Pregnancy.** Fennel has very mild oestrogen-like activity at heavy daily intake; keep it occasional in pregnancy and check with a midwife.
- **Persistent symptoms.** Ongoing bloating, pain or changed bowel habit needs a GP, not a stronger cup.

FAQ

Does fennel tea help bloating? Fennel is a traditional carminative with reasonable support for easing wind and bloating; the tea effect is gentle and comforting, not a cure.

Is it caffeine-free? Yes.

Any additives? No. It is pure fennel seed, which is why it tastes drier and more herbal than flavoured aniseed blends.

When should I drink it? After meals, or as a settling evening cup.

Watch	Keep occasional in pregnancy; persistent symptoms need a GP

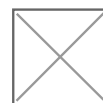
