- Colour contrast targeted at WCAG AA (4.5:1 for normal text).
- Plain-English product and brewing guidance.

Known limitations

We are actively reviewing the site. Some older editorial pages and third-party embedded content may not yet fully conform; we remediate issues as we find them and welcome reports.

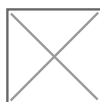
