Quick answer: **PG Tips** is the more direct choice for familiar everyday black tea, including Original, Gold and Decaf. **Twinings** is the broader cupboard, with dozens of green, fruit, herbal, wellbeing and international blends.

PG Tips and Twinings are both historic British names, but the live ranges now solve different shopping problems. Compare the products you would actually brew, not just the familiarity of the logos.

Where Twinings wins

Twinings wins on navigation by flavour and occasion. The current catalogue includes plain and flavoured green teas, peppermint and camomile, fruit infusions, Sleep, Calm, Focus and other named blends, plus selected international black teas. That range makes Twinings useful when a household wants variety without learning a new brand for each style.

Where PG Tips wins

PG Tips is easier when the brief is simply a familiar black brew with milk. Original covers the standard cup, Gold is the richer option, Decaf handles a lower-caffeine requirement, and the 400-bag pack serves high-volume kitchens. Its current official portfolio also presents those three core choices clearly.

Which one is right for you?

- **Choose PG Tips** for everyday black tea, a large shared pack or a simple Original/Gold/Decaf ladder.
- **Choose Twinings** for a wider mix of green, herbal, flavoured and wellbeing-labelled infusions.
- **Compare ingredients** when a blend name sounds functional; a product name is not medical evidence.
- **Compare bag count and tea weight**, not box price alone.

How to make the comparison fairly

Brew two products with the same mug, water volume and steep time before deciding that one brand is stronger. PG Tips Original is designed for a milk-friendly everyday cup, while a Twinings peppermint or fruit infusion has a different base and should not be judged by black-tea colour. If you compare PG Tips with a Twinings international black tea, use the same water and milk, taste them unlabelled if possible, and repeat on a second day. Familiarity is powerful: the tea you grew up with can taste “correct” before the leaves have

had a fair hearing.

How this comparison was made

We began with the live Teas.co.uk catalogue rather than a generic list of famous products. A product had to be published and available at the 8 August 2026 snapshot to appear in a current shortlist. We then checked ownership, sourcing or certification statements against official company or industry sources. No brand paid for inclusion or position, and the shop has not supplied a hidden ranking score.

Price per bag is calculated as the displayed box price divided by the stated bag count and rounded to one decimal place. It is a useful household measure, but it cannot tell you leaf weight, blend quality, ethical performance or how strong you brew. A 20-bag herbal infusion is not automatically poor value beside an 80-bag breakfast tea; they may be different products for different occasions.

Use the comparison as a route into the right shelf, then open the live product page before ordering. Check today's stock, price, ingredients, allergens, caffeine statement and disposal instructions on the current pack.

If a factual source changes, the dated review note tells you when this page should be checked again.

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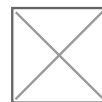
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
