

Yogi Tea vs Pukka

Quick answer: **Yogi Tea** tends towards aromatic spice-led blends inspired by Ayurveda, usually in 17-bag boxes. **Pukka** tends towards rounded multi-herb recipes in 20-bag boxes. Both official sources describe their ranges as organic; choose by ingredients and taste, not by a promised treatment.

Yogi Tea and Pukka occupy the same organic herbal shelf, but they do not taste interchangeable. This comparison separates what is on the label from what a cup can responsibly promise.

Range snapshot

At the 8 August snapshot all 15 published Yogi Tea products and all 13 published Pukka products on Teas.co.uk were in stock. Yogi examples clustered around chai spices, ginger, liquorice and named wellbeing blends. Pukka examples included mint, ginger, night-time, relaxation and mixed-herb recipes.

Organic and packaging claims

Yogi's official quality page states that its varieties are certified organic and carry the EU organic seal, and its packaging page describes the tea bag itself as compostable while acknowledging a thin heat-seal coating inside the individual envelope. Pukka's official portfolio describes its herbal creations as organic and its boxes as sustainably sourced cardboard. Those statements apply at brand level; always check the pack in your hand for the disposal instruction that applies to that exact component.

A note on wellbeing names

Bedtime, Relax, Detox, Immune Support and Stomach Ease are product names, not clinical conclusions. An infusion can be pleasant, caffeine-free and part of a routine without treating insomnia, digestive illness or infection. If a health condition, pregnancy or medicine makes an ingredient important, read the full pack and ask an appropriate health professional.

Which should you buy?

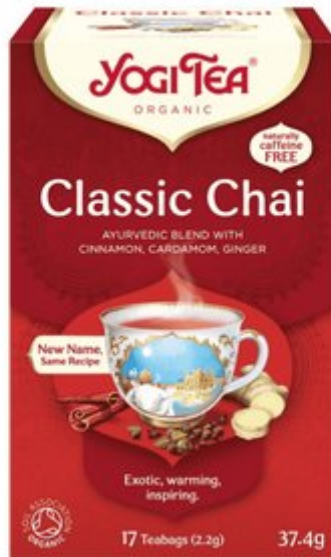
- **Choose Yogi** if you enjoy assertive spice, chai-like warmth or liquorice-root sweetness.
- **Choose Pukka** if you prefer softer layered herbals or want 20 bags rather than 17.
- **Avoid blind variety packs** when you dislike liquorice: it appears in many herbal formulations.
- **For caffeine-free tea**, confirm that the box is a herbal infusion rather than green or black tea.

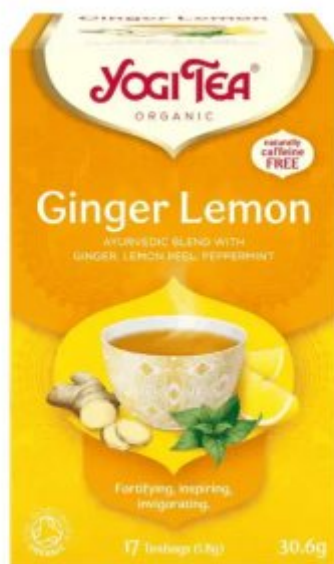

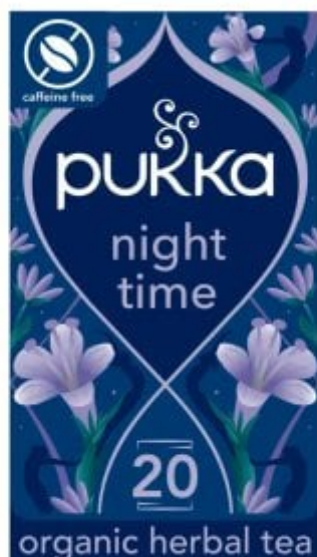

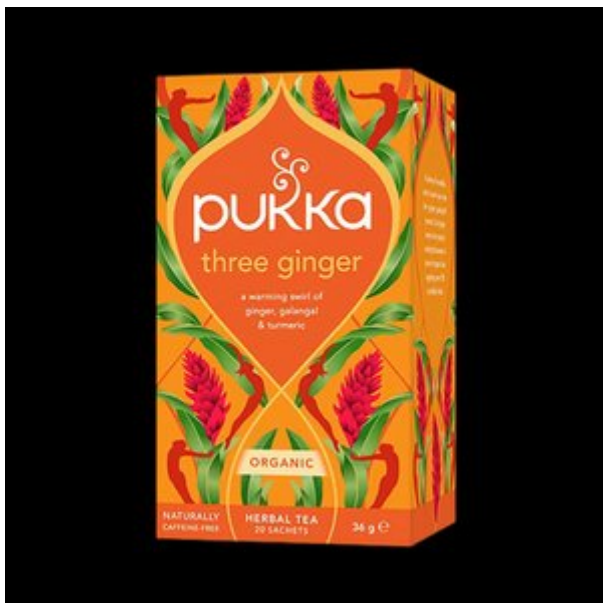

How this comparison was made

We began with the live Teas.co.uk catalogue rather than a generic list of famous products. A product had to be published and available at the 8 August 2026 snapshot to appear in a current shortlist. We then checked ownership, sourcing or certification statements against official company or industry sources. No brand paid for inclusion or position, and the shop has not supplied a hidden ranking score.

Price per bag is calculated as the displayed box price divided by the stated bag count and rounded to one decimal place. It is a useful household measure, but it cannot tell you leaf weight, blend quality, ethical performance or how strong you brew. A 20-bag herbal infusion is not automatically poor value beside an 80-bag breakfast tea; they may be different products for different occasions.

Use the comparison as a route into the right shelf, then open the live product page before ordering. Check today's stock, price, ingredients, allergens, caffeine statement and disposal instructions on the current pack. If a factual source changes, the dated review note tells you when this page should be checked again.

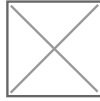

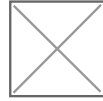
