Quick answer: Pick Tetley Super Teas by **base and flavour**: berry or peach-orange fruit infusions, mango-pineapple or strawberry-raspberry green tea, or mint-fennel herbal tea. Boost, Immune, Defence, Revitalise and Happy Tummy are product labels—not clinical results.

Highly polished against the live shop on 8 August 2026. Stock and price are dated snapshots.

Five similarly priced boxes split into three different drink families. Identifying the base tea first prevents a fruit infusion, green tea and herbal blend from being judged as though they were the same cup.

First divide the range into three

Super Fruits, Super Green and Super Herbal are not cosmetic sub-labels. Fruit infusions, green tea and herbals differ in source plant, natural caffeine position and flavour structure. Once the base is clear, compare blueberry-raspberry with peach-orange, or mango-pineapple with strawberry-raspberry.

Added vitamins need a current label

Some Super products are marketed around added vitamins. The exact nutrient, amount and permitted wording belong to the current pack, not to an evergreen Wiki promise. Formulations can change, so the product page and box must be checked on the day of purchase.

Taste beyond the front-panel name

Berry blends may lean tart, especially where hibiscus or rosehip appears. Tropical fruit can soften green tea, while mint and fennel create a distinctly savoury-cooling herbal cup. Read ingredient order to understand what is carrying the flavour instead of assuming the pictured fruit dominates.

Health language kept in bounds

This guide does not rank immunity, digestion, energy or mood effects. It can responsibly explain the product type, ingredients and flavour route. A person with symptoms, medicine interactions or dietary concerns needs the label and appropriate professional guidance.

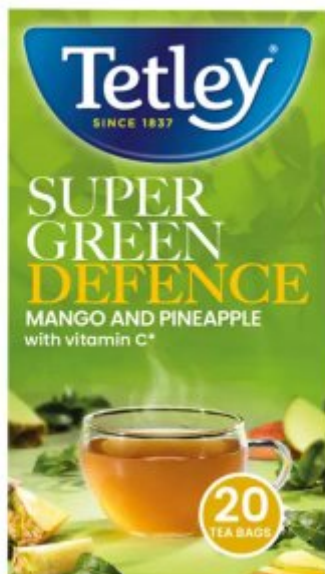

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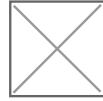
