Quick answer: For a high-turnover office, **PG Tips 400** and **Tetley 400** minimise reordering. **Yorkshire Original 80** suits a smaller team, while **PG Tips Decaf 70** creates an essential second caddy. Add a caffeine-free herbal option rather than treating one black tea as universal.

Highly polished against the live shop on 8 August 2026. Stock and price are dated snapshots.

Office tea is procurement, inclusion and storage in one small cupboard. The cheapest bag is not the best system if it goes stale, runs out unpredictably or excludes half the team.

Calculate demand before buying bulk

Count staff, average tea drinkers, cups per working day and remote-office patterns. Ten people averaging two cups on three office days use about 60 bags a week; 400 lasts roughly six to seven weeks. A mostly remote team may take far longer and needs a smaller box.

Build a minimum inclusive shelf

Start with one regular black tea, one clearly labelled decaf black tea and one verified caffeine-free herbal or rooibos option. Keep allergens and ingredient information accessible. A larger range is welcome only if somebody owns rotation and reordering.

Storage and hygiene

Keep reserve bags sealed, dry and away from sink steam, cleaning chemicals, coffee and microwave odours. Refill a washable caddy in sensible quantities. Do not tip a fresh box on top of old forgotten bags; rotate stock so the oldest is used first.

Price per cup is only one cost

Include delivery cadence, cupboard space, staff time, waste and emergency supermarket runs. The apparent saving on a 400 box disappears quickly if the team dislikes it or stock is allowed to stale. Record what actually gets used before the next order.

- **High turnover:** trial PG Tips 400 against Tetley 400 with the team.
- **Smaller office:** Yorkshire Original 80 or another known favourite.
- **Decaf:** PG Tips Decaf in a separate labelled container.
- **Inclusion:** add at least one caffeine-free herbal and provide dairy-free milk where appropriate.
