Decaf tea is real tea with the [caffeine](#) stripped out, not a herbal substitute. Done well, it tastes nearly identical to the caffeinated version, close enough that most drinkers cannot tell the difference side by side. Done badly, it tastes thin, slightly papery, and reminds you why you avoid it. The gap is mostly in the decaffeination process the manufacturer chose. This guide tells you which UK decaf options are genuinely good and which to avoid.

How tea is decaffeinated

Three processes are used commercially:

- **CO2 (carbon dioxide) decaf.** Pressurised liquid CO2 selectively binds caffeine and removes it. No solvents, no chemical residue, minimal flavour loss. The premium method. Used by most premium UK brands ([Twinings](#), Whittard, Clipper Organic).
- **Water process (Swiss water).** Tea is soaked in water, the water is run through a carbon filter that removes caffeine, and the leaves are reintroduced to flavour rich water. No chemicals. Slightly more flavour loss than CO2. Used by some organic and ethical brands.
- **Ethyl acetate ("naturally decaffeinated").** Ethyl acetate is a naturally occurring solvent (found in fruit). Effective and safe; the marketing friendly term is "naturally decaffeinated" because the solvent is natural. Slightly more flavour stripping than CO2. Used by mass market budget brands.

All three are food safe and produce decaf with 95-99% caffeine removed. The flavour difference between CO2 and ethyl acetate decaf in a side by side blind tasting is real but small.

The five UK decaf teas worth your money

1. **[Yorkshire Tea Decaf](#)**. The closest decaf to its caffeinated parent on the UK market. CO2 process. Same Yorkshire malty character. The default recommendation for any Yorkshire drinker who wants an evening cup. £0.04 per cup. [Quick Buy: Yorkshire Decaf 80s](#).
2. **[Twinings Earl Grey Decaf](#)**. The only widely available decaf Earl Grey worth drinking. [Bergamot](#) character preserved well. £0.10 per cup. The pick for evening Earl Grey drinkers.
3. **[Clipper Organic Decaf English Breakfast](#)**. Organic, [Fairtrade](#), CO2 process. Cleaner cup than the mass market options. £0.10 per cup. Pick if you want organic + decaf in the same cup.
4. **Tetley Decaf**. The supermarket benchmark. Clear, drinkable, slightly lighter than caffeinated Tetley. £0.04 per cup. A solid value option.
5. **PG Tips Decaf**. The brisk Kenyan led blend, decaffeinated. Stronger character than Tetley Decaf. £0.05 per cup.

Decaf speciality teas

Decaf is not just for breakfast blends:

- **Decaf green tea** Tetley Decaf Green, Clipper Organic Decaf Green. Both reasonable; the catechins are mostly preserved through decaffeination so the antioxidant content is similar to caffeinated green.
- **Decaf chai** exists but rare in the UK. Yogi makes one. The chai spices dominate, so the absence of caffeine isn't very noticeable.
- **Decaf Darjeeling / Assam** premium decaf, niche, around £0.30-0.50 per cup. Whittard occasionally stocks. Worth it for the discerning evening drinker.

How much caffeine is left?

Approximately **2-5mg per 200ml cup**. For comparison, a strong caffeinated black tea is 50mg, a coffee is 80-100mg, and a chamomile infusion is zero. Decaf is not zero, but it is far below the threshold most caffeine sensitive drinkers can detect. Pregnancy NHS guideline (200mg/day max) accommodates several cups of decaf without issue.

Decaf vs caffeine free herbal, which to pick

If your goal is "tea tasting hot drink in the evening", decaf wins. The cup tastes like tea because it is tea.

If your goal is "absolutely zero caffeine for medical or sensitivity reasons", caffeine free herbal infusions (chamomile, rooibos, peppermint, fruit teas) win because they contain none rather than 2-5mg.

If you are pregnant and want to keep drinking tea, decaf is widely considered fine in moderate amounts. If you have severe caffeine sensitivity (palpitations from a single cup), switch to caffeine free herbals to be safe.

How to brew decaf properly

Decaf benefits from **30-60 seconds longer steep** than the caffeinated version because the decaffeination process strips a small amount of flavour. A Yorkshire Tea Decaf brewed for 4 minutes 30 seconds tastes closer to caffeinated Yorkshire brewed for 4 minutes than the same time would. Beyond that, the brewing rules are identical to the caffeinated parent: just boiled water, 200ml, milk to taste.

Common decaf complaints, addressed

"Decaf tastes thin." Usually because you brewed it the same length as caffeinated. Add 30 seconds.

"Decaf tastes papery." A sign of cheap ethyl acetate processing or oxidised stale leaf. Switch to a CO₂-processed brand (Yorkshire, Twinings, Clipper Organic).

"Decaf still keeps me awake." Possible (2-5mg is real) but unlikely from one cup. More likely the bedtime routine, screens, or other diet caffeine. Switch to chamomile or rooibos for an absolute control test.

FAQ

What is the best decaf tea in the UK? Yorkshire Tea Decaf for the everyday cup; Twinings Earl Grey Decaf for flavoured; Clipper Organic Decaf English Breakfast for organic.

Is decaf tea actually caffeine free? No. 2-5mg per cup remains. For absolute zero, drink chamomile, rooibos, fruit infusions, or peppermint.

Is decaf safe in pregnancy? Yes, UK NHS guideline of 200mg caffeine per day accommodates several cups of decaf without issue. Many pregnant drinkers switch to decaf as a baseline.

Does decaf have the same antioxidants? Yes, catechins and theaflavins are largely preserved through decaffeination. The antioxidant content is similar to the caffeinated version.

How can you tell which decaffeination process was used? Premium brands often state CO₂ or Swiss water process on the box. If unstated, assume ethyl acetate. Yorkshire Tea publishes that they use CO₂.

Curator's note: a 4pm Yorkshire Decaf with milk is one of life's quiet pleasures. The cup tastes nearly identical to the caffeinated version, and you sleep. If you have given up tea after lunch because of caffeine, try good decaf rather than herbal, you might find your evening cup back. Lee, Teas.co.uk, Tunbridge Wells.

Decaf is real tea with the caffeine stripped, not a herbal substitute, and done well it is close enough that most drinkers cannot tell side by side. The process is the whole story: CO2 (carbon dioxide) is the premium, flavour preserving method, water process is solvent free and close behind, ethyl acetate is the cheaper mass market route with a little more flavour stripping. Yorkshire Tea Decaf is the closest to its caffeinated parent; Twinings Earl Grey Decaf the flavoured pick; Clipper Organic the organic one. Brew it thirty to sixty seconds longer than the caffeinated version. It keeps two to five milligrams of caffeine, not zero, so the very sensitive should pick a caffeine free herbal instead. 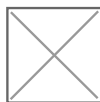
