The plain answer to "what is the best [Earl Grey](#) tea in the UK?" is "depends what you mean by best". Best for an everyday £0.06 cup is not the same as best for a once a month proper [afternoon](#) teapot. Best with milk is not the same as best black. Best with delicate food is not the same as best to wake you up. This page ranks the eight Earl Greys we'd actually recommend across those buckets, with straight pricing and plain verdicts.

Three variables matter:

- **Bergamot quality.** Real Calabrian bergamot oil tastes complex and rounded; cheap synthetic bergamot tastes flat and slightly chemical. The premium tier uses real oil; the [supermarket](#) cheap end usually doesn't disclose.
- **Black tea base quality.** A good Earl Grey starts with a respectable Ceylon or Indian black. Cheap Earl Grey often uses dust grade fannings, the bergamot disguises some of it, but the cup is thin.
- **Bergamot balance.** Too much bergamot turns into perfume; too little and you might as well drink [English Breakfast](#). The benchmark is "you can taste both the tea and the bergamot in every sip."

Tier 1: Premium loose leaf (£0.30+ per cup)

1. [Whittard Earl Grey \(loose\)](#). Ceylon base, real Calabrian bergamot oil. The benchmark for proper afternoon teapot Earl Grey. Bergamot rounded, never sharp; tea base full bodied. £0.50 per cup. Worth it for occasions.
2. [Williamson Earl Grey](#). Single estate Ceylon base. Slightly brighter and more citrusy than Whittard. £0.45 per cup. Excellent if you want a more vibrant cup.
3. [Dragonfly Earl Grey Rooibos](#). Caffeine free wildcard, black tea swapped for rooibos. The bergamot still works, the cup is sweeter and woodier, evening drinkable. £0.30 per cup. The "best Earl Grey for evenings" answer.

Tier 2: Premium bagged (£0.10-0.30)

4. [Teapigs Earl Grey Strong](#). Pyramid bag, double strength bergamot, brisk Indian Ceylon blend. £0.35 per cup. The pick for drinkers who find standard Earl Grey too subtle.
5. [Twinings Earl Grey Strong](#). The supermarket tier "stronger" version. £0.10 per cup. Reliable.

Tier 3: Everyday bagged (£0.05-0.10)

6. [Twinings Earl Grey Original](#). The supermarket benchmark. The cup most British drinkers think of when they think Earl Grey. Reliable, well balanced, fairly priced. £0.07 per cup. The default recommendation if you don't know where to start.
7. [Twinings Lady Grey](#). Earl Grey with added orange and lemon peel. Lighter, more citrus forward, less bergamot dominant. Good with milk if standard Earl Grey is too perfumed. £0.08 per cup.
8. [Tetley Earl Grey](#). The value option. Clear, drinkable, slightly lighter character than Twinings. £0.04 per cup. Buy if budget is tight.

The "best" depends on the question

Should Earl Grey have milk?

Both work. Black is traditional and lets the bergamot stand out, choose this for premium loose leaf and afternoon tea. Milk softens the bergamot and gives a more conventional cuppa, choose this for everyday Twinings or Tetley with breakfast. We do not have a hard opinion either way; we drink it both ways depending on the cup.

How to brew Earl Grey properly

Pour just boiled water (95-100°C) over the leaf or bag. Steep **3-4 minutes** for bagged, 4-5 for loose leaf. Longer than that and the bergamot oils begin to over extract and the cup turns soapy. Earl Grey is one of the few black teas where over brewing genuinely hurts the cup.

FAQ

What is the strongest Earl Grey UK? Teapigs Earl Grey Strong by bergamot intensity; Twinings Earl Grey Strong on the supermarket aisle.

Is Whittard Earl Grey better than Twinings? Yes, better bergamot, better tea base, fuller cup. But Twinings is six times cheaper, so for everyday cups the value calculation is different.

What is Lady Grey? A Twinings trademark, Earl Grey with added orange and lemon peel. Lighter than standard Earl Grey, more citrus forward.

Best Earl Grey for afternoon tea? Whittard Earl Grey loose, in a porcelain pot, brewed 4 minutes, served black. The bergamot pairs particularly well with cucumber sandwiches and lemon flavoured pastries.

Caffeine free Earl Grey options? Twinings Earl Grey Decaf for the closest match; Dragonfly Earl Grey Rooibos for a true zero caffeine version with a different (but excellent) character.

Curator's note: I drink Twinings Earl Grey for my morning cup and Whittard loose for guests. Most people don't need anything more complicated than that. Lee, Teas.co.uk, Tunbridge Wells.

There is no single best Earl Grey, only the best for the job: Twinings Earl Grey Original is the everyday benchmark, Whittard loose the afternoon teapot occasion cup, Teapigs Earl Grey Strong for bergamot turned up, Dragonfly Earl Grey Rooibos the caffeine free evening answer, Lady Grey the lighter citrus version, Tetley the cheap reliable one. Judge it on real bergamot, a decent black base, and the two staying

in balance, then brew it short, three to four minutes, because over steeping turns Earl Grey soapy.

Pick your Earl Grey: the everyday benchmark from [Twinings](#), bergamot turned up from [Teapigs](#), the caffeine free evening version from [Dragonfly](#), or single estate from [Williamson](#). Browse the full [Earl Grey range](#).

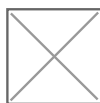
