

Cheapest Tea UK

Cheapest tea in the UK, in summary: The cheapest UK tea is supermarket own brand 240-bag boxes at 1-3p a cup; mainstream Yorkshire, Tetley, PG Tips at 4-8p. Drinkable, with the trade offs.

The cheapest tea in the UK is [supermarket](#) own brand 240-bag boxes, Co op 99 Tea, Sainsbury's Red Label, Tesco Everyday Value, Asda Smartprice, at 3-5p per cup. Mass market brand champions [Yorkshire](#) Tea, Tetley, PG Tips at 6-8p per cup. The "cheap and cheerful" category at the under-5p tier is genuinely drinkable; quality has improved over the past 20 years.

Supermarket own brand value tier (3-5p per cup)

- **Tesco Everyday Value Tea Bags.** ~£2.50 for 240 bags. ~1p per cup at scale.
- **Asda Smartprice Tea.** Similar pricing.
- **Sainsbury's Basics Tea.** Similar pricing.
- **Morrisons Savers Tea.** Similar pricing.
- **Co op 99 Tea.** Slightly higher (~3p per cup) but quality reputation.
- **Aldi Specially Selected.** Mid tier own brand.
- **Lidl own brand.** Mid tier own brand.

Mid tier own brand (4-7p per cup)

- Sainsbury's Red Label.
- Tesco Original.

- Asda standard tea bags.
- Morrisons standard.

Mass market brand workhorses (6-8p per cup)

- Yorkshire Tea 240-bag.
- Tetley 240-bag.
- PG Tips 240-bag.
- [Twinings English Breakfast](#) (slightly higher tier, 8-10p).

Quality at the cheapest tier

Honest assessment of supermarket own brand value tea:

- **Drinkable.** Yes, basic strong British [black tea](#).
- **Quality vs mainstream brands?** Slightly less consistent; less premium leaf grade.
- **With milk + sugar?** Hard to distinguish from mainstream brands.
- **Black drinking?** Quality difference more apparent.
- **Premium tea drinkers?** Will notice the difference.
- **Mass market workplace tea?** Genuinely fine.

Why cheap tea works

The [blending](#) tradition

Mainstream British tea is blended, multiple origins combined for consistent character. Even cheap tea uses competent blending; the difference is leaf grade and provenance, not absence of professional craft.

Volume economics

Tea blending and packaging at scale is genuinely cheap. The supermarket own brand model passes most savings to consumers.

Milk and sugar masking

British everyday tea drinking with milk and sugar masks subtle quality differences. Premium leaf differences are harder to detect through milk.

How to evaluate cheap tea

Side by side test

Brew a cup of cheap own brand and a cup of mainstream brand at the same time. Same brewing parameters. Drink both. Identify any meaningful difference.

Cost per year calculation

4-cup a day household, 365 days:

- Tesco Value: £15 annually.
- Yorkshire Tea: £75-90 annually.
- Twinings English Breakfast: £80-120 annually.
- Pukka Three Mint daily: £350-400 annually (much lower volume).

When cheap tea genuinely makes sense

- Workplace tea round (multiple drinkers, occasional drinkers).
- Multiple cups daily for tea as fuel scenarios.
- Pot brewing for hospitality.
- Travel tea (hotel room kettle).
- Cooking with tea ([Earl Grey](#) shortbread, tea smoked salmon).
- Backup tea (running out of premium).

When cheap tea is false economy

- You're a serious tea enthusiast and notice quality differences.
- You drink tea black (no milk to mask).
- You drink one cup daily as ritual (premium worth it).
- You're hosting and want quality.
- The "cheap" tea is past best by date and stale (false economy).

Cheapest black tea

Tesco Everyday Value, Asda Smartprice, Sainsbury's Basics. ~1-2p per cup.

Cheapest decaf

Tetley Decaf 240-bag. ~7-9p per cup.

Cheapest green tea

Twinings Pure Green 80-bag. ~5p per cup.

Cheapest herbal

[Twinings Pure Camomile](#), Heath & Heather Pure Peppermint. ~5-8p per cup.

Cheapest Earl Grey

Twinings Earl Grey 80-bag. ~5p per cup.

How to make cheap tea taste better

1. Use just boiled water (not lukewarm).
2. Steep for the full 4-5 minutes (don't rush).
3. Use one bag per cup (not pot brewing too thinly).
4. Cover the cup during steep.
5. Squeeze the bag at the end.
6. Use whole milk (not skimmed).
7. Drink within 10 minutes of brewing.

Good technique elevates cheap tea more than premium tea elevates poor technique.

Free shipping considerations

If buying online, the £35 free shipping threshold is hard to hit with single boxes of supermarket tier tea. Combine with other tea or household items to cross the threshold.

FAQ

Cheapest UK tea? Supermarket Value tier own brand at 1-3p per cup.

Is cheap tea bad? Less premium, but mass market British tea is generally drinkable across all price tiers.

How much can I save? Switching from Yorkshire (5-6p/cup) to Tesco Value (1p/cup) saves £60-80 annually for 4-cup a day household.

Worth it? Depends on your tea drinking style. Mass market brand fans should stick with their preference; budget focused households can save substantially.

Loose leaf cheapest? Yorkshire Tea, Tetley loose leaf at supermarket. ~10-15p per cup.

Curator's note: the cheapest UK tea is supermarket own brand at 1-3p per cup. Quality is acceptable for most everyday use. Premium worth paying for if you drink tea black or care about subtle differences. Lee, Teas.co.uk, Tunbridge Wells.

The value sweet spot most drinkers want: supermarket own brand at 1-3p a cup is the cheapest and fine for most everyday use; mainstream Yorkshire, Tetley or PG Tips at 4-8p is the meaningfully better but still cheap middle; premium is worth paying for only if you drink black or care about subtle differences. The per-cup method is in [cost per cup](#); buy a sound everyday tea via [Yorkshire Tea](#) or the full [tea shop](#).
