

# Decaf English Breakfast

Decaf [English Breakfast Tea](#) is the unsung hero of the UK tea shelf, the cup that lets you drink five mugs of breakfast tea without disrupting sleep, lets pregnant drinkers enjoy proper tea without exceeding the NHS [caffeine](#) limit, and tastes nearly indistinguishable from caffeinated EB once you brew it properly. Modern CO2-process decaffeination is dramatically better than the old methylene chloride process. This is the working guide.

Decaffeinated tea has had 95-99% of its caffeine removed by an industrial process applied to the dried leaves before packaging. The remaining caffeine is typically 2-5mg per cup, compared to 40-50mg in caffeinated English Breakfast.

**Decaf is NOT caffeine free.** The 2-5mg residual is small enough that most caffeine sensitive drinkers don't notice it, but it's not zero. For full caffeine free, you need herbal infusions (rooibos, [chamomile](#), [peppermint](#)).

## CO2 process (the modern method)

Tea leaves are placed in a sealed chamber. Pressurised liquid CO2 is passed through. CO2 selectively binds to caffeine and carries it out of the leaves. The CO2 is recycled. No solvents, no chemicals, the process is essentially "supercritical fluid extraction" using carbon dioxide as the solvent.

Brands using CO2: [Yorkshire](#) Tea Decaf, [Twinings](#) Decaf, most premium decaf brands. The cup tastes dramatically closer to caffeinated than older methods.

### **Water process (sometimes called Swiss Water)**

Tea leaves are soaked in water. The water is passed through carbon filters that capture caffeine but let flavour compounds through. The "decaf flavoured" water is then re applied to fresh leaves. Multi stage process. No chemicals; high quality result.

### **Methylene chloride process (older method)**

Tea leaves are soaked in methylene chloride solvent. Caffeine dissolves into the solvent; solvent is removed by evaporation. The process is effective but flavour stripping. Most major UK brands have moved away from this. Some commodity decaf still uses it, check the box if you want to avoid.

### **Ethyl acetate process**

Sometimes called "natural decaffeination" because ethyl acetate occurs naturally in some fruits. Tea soaked in ethyl acetate solvent; solvent removed. Less common in UK; more common in coffee decaffeination.

CO2 process	pressurised carbon dioxide strips caffeine; the modern method	best flavour retention; tastes close to caffeinated
Water (Swiss Water)	caffeine removed via water and filters, no solvent	good, gentle; solvent free reassurance
Methylene chloride	older solvent method	more flavour loss; the cup people "remember" as washed out
Ethyl acetate	solvent ("naturally derived") method	moderate; can leave a faint note

### **Yorkshire Tea Decaf**

The most popular UK decaf breakfast tea. CO2 decaffeinated. Cup tastes very close to caffeinated Yorkshire, same Assam led malty character, slightly less robustness. Box of 80 bags ~£3-4. [Quick Buy:](#)

### **Tetley Decaf**

Tetley's decaf is slightly lighter than caffeinated Tetley (already lighter than Yorkshire). Reasonable everyday cup. CO2 process. Mainstream supermarket option.

### **Twinings English Breakfast Decaf**

CO2 process. Slightly more refined than Yorkshire or Tetley decaf, drinks closer to a Ceylon Assam blend than a pure Assam. Premium pricing.

### **PG Tips Decaf**

CO2 process. Closer in cup to caffeinated PG Tips. Mainstream option.

### **Specialist decaf English Breakfast**

- **Whittard English Breakfast Decaf.** Premium UK brand, well balanced.
- **Clipper Decaf English Breakfast.** Fairtrade, organic, plastic free bags.

### **How to brew decaf for maximum flavour**

Most people under brew decaf because they're treating it like instant coffee: pour, dunk, drink. Decaf benefits from a slightly longer steep than caffeinated.

1. 1 bag per 200ml mug.
2. Water at full rolling boil.
3. Steep 4-5 minutes (slightly longer than the 3-4 you'd give caffeinated). The decaffeination process slightly extends extraction time.
4. Add milk and sugar to taste. Decaf takes milk and sugar identically to caffeinated EB.

NHS recommends pregnant women limit caffeine to 200mg per day. Decaf English Breakfast at 2-5mg per cup means even 10 cups remains comfortably under the threshold. For pregnant drinkers who want to maintain a 5-6 cups a day British tea habit, decaf is the practical answer.

### **What you lose vs caffeinated**

Decaffeination removes:

- **95-99% of caffeine.** The intended effect.
- **Some polyphenols (5-15%).** Especially with older methylene chloride process; CO2 is gentler.
- **Slight aromatic complexity.** A trained palate can taste the difference; most casual drinkers can't.
- **Some L theanine.** Small reduction.

What you keep:

- **Most polyphenols.** The "tea is good for you" components survive decaffeination largely intact.
- **The flavour structure.** Especially with CO2 process. Cup is recognisably the same tea.
- **The ritual.** A proper brew, milk, sugar, biscuit, the everyday tea experience is preserved.

## When to drink decaf English Breakfast

- **Evenings.** 4pm onwards if caffeine affects your sleep.
- **Multiple cups per day.** 8-10 cups daily of caffeinated would push 400-500mg caffeine, too much for most adults. Switch to decaf for the bulk.
- **Pregnancy.** Stays well within NHS limits.
- **Caffeine sensitive drinkers.** Migraine sufferers, anxiety prone, evening drinkers.
- **Children.** Caffeine is generally not recommended for children. Decaf delivers the social ritual without the stimulant.

## FAQ

**Is decaf English Breakfast safe in pregnancy?** Yes, at 2-5mg per cup, it's well within NHS guidelines. Drink as much as you like.

**Does decaf have less flavour?** Modern CO<sub>2</sub>-decaffeinated tea tastes very close to caffeinated. The difference is real but subtle for most drinkers.

**Best decaf English Breakfast UK?** Yorkshire Tea Decaf for closeness to caffeinated. Twinings Decaf for refinement. Clipper for organic plastic free.

**Is decaf the same as caffeine free?** No, decaf retains 2-5mg per cup. Caffeine free is 0mg (rooibos, chamomile, peppermint).

**How is the caffeine removed?** Modern brands use CO<sub>2</sub> (carbon dioxide) extraction. No solvents, no chemicals, just pressurised CO<sub>2</sub> as a selective solvent.

*Curator's note: decaf English Breakfast is the most underrated tea in our range. Modern CO<sub>2</sub> decaf tastes near identical to caffeinated, fits any pregnancy or evening situation, and lets you drink eight cups a day without consequences. Yorkshire Tea Decaf is what we drink at home after 4pm. Lee, Teas.co.uk, Tunbridge Wells.*
