Dilmah is the Sri Lankan family owned tea brand built around a single principle: Ceylon tea is best when it's single origin, ethically traded, and the value stays in Sri Lanka. Founded in 1988 by Merrill Fernando, one of the first Sri Lankans to train as a tea taster in London, Dilmah is now one of the world's most recognised single origin specialty tea brands. The cup is bright, clean, and consistently among the best Pure Ceylon you can buy.

The founder's story

Merrill Fernando trained as a tea taster in London in the 1950s. For three decades he watched Western tea brands buy Sri Lankan tea cheaply, blend it with cheaper origins, and sell it at premium prices in the UK and US, with most of the profit staying outside Sri Lanka. In 1988, at age 58, he started Dilmah. The name combines the names of his sons Dilhan and Malik. The mission was clear: Sri Lankan tea, packed in Sri Lanka, owned by Sri Lankans.

The brand's "Real Tea" positioning rejected the idea that Ceylon tea should be a commodity input for global blends. Single origin, single estate, and direct from source became the Dilmah promise.

What Dilmah stands for

- **Single origin tea.** Every Dilmah tea is grown, processed, and packed in Sri Lanka. No multi origin [blending](#).
- **Family owned.** Still run by the Fernando family. No private equity, no multinational conglomerate ownership.
- **Ethically priced.** The brand's commitment to fair worker compensation through the MJF Foundation goes well beyond commodity pricing.
- **Quality focused.** No race to the bottom commodity products. Mid to premium tier across the range.
- **Educational.** Strong commitment to tea tasting education; Dilmah's School of Tea trains tea professionals globally.

Premium / Pure Ceylon line

The flagship single origin [black tea](#). Bright, citrusy, balanced. The cup that introduces most drinkers to Dilmah.

Watte single region range

"Watte" means "garden" in Sinhalese. The Watte range showcases specific Ceylon districts:

- **Yata Watte (Low grown).** Bold, full bodied. Strongest cup of the line.
- **Meda Watte (Mid grown).** Balanced, malty.
- **Ran Watte (High grown).** Bright, refined.
- **Uda Watte (Highest grown).** Most delicate, almost green leaning.

Tasting the four side by side is one of the most accessible introductions to Ceylon altitude variation.

Single region teas

Specific Ceylon districts: Nuwara Eliya, Dimbula, Uva, Kandy. Premium pricing; distinctive regional characters.

[Earl Grey](#) and flavoured teas

[Dilmah Earl Grey](#) uses Ceylon as the base, brighter than typical UK Earl Grey. Other flavoured teas: Vanilla, Cinnamon, Strawberry, Apple. All built on Ceylon black tea base.

[Green tea](#) range

Sri Lankan green tea is a smaller production category but Dilmah does it well. Lighter and less grassy than [Japanese](#) green; more vegetal than Chinese green.

Specialty range

[White Tea](#), oolong, herbal blends. Smaller production lines.

Vs [Twinings](#) Pure Ceylon

Dilmah is single origin and Sri Lankan owned; Twinings Pure Ceylon is Sri Lankan tea, UK blended. Dilmah is fresher and more characterful; Twinings is cheaper and more accessible.

Vs Mlesna

Both Sri Lankan brands. Mlesna positions more as a gift and tin specialist; Dilmah as the everyday quality single origin brand. Both excellent.

Vs [Hyson](#)

Hyson is also Sri Lankan but more accessible price tier. Dilmah is the premium Sri Lankan owned option.

Vs specialist single estate Ceylons

Lumbini, Pedro, Madulkelle estate teas are premium tier with traceable single estate provenance. Dilmah's Watta range is the closest mainstream parallel.

How to brew Dilmah

Standard Ceylon brewing applies:

1. 1 tsp loose leaf or 1 bag per 200ml.
2. Water at full rolling boil. Ceylon needs heat.
3. Steep 3-5 minutes.
4. Drink black, with lemon, or with a small amount of milk. Ceylon is versatile.

The Merrill J. Fernando Charitable Foundation funds:

- Healthcare and education for tea estate workers and their families in Sri Lanka
- Disability inclusion and special education programmes
- Disaster relief and humanitarian aid
- Sri Lankan biodiversity and conservation

A meaningful portion of Dilmah's revenue funds the foundation. Buying Dilmah is one of the more directly impactful tea purchases on the UK shelf, your cup contributes to a real social mission.

Caffeine

40-50mg per 200ml cup. Standard Ceylon black tea range. Slightly lower for high grown Nuwara Eliya and Uda Watte.

FAQ

Is Dilmah genuinely Sri Lankan? Yes, family owned, Sri Lankan headquartered, single origin. One of the most authentic Ceylon brands globally.

Best Dilmah tea? Premium Pure Ceylon for the everyday flagship. The Watte single region range for tasting altitude variation.

Is Dilmah expensive? Mid premium pricing, more than supermarket Ceylon, less than specialist single estate tea. Good value for the quality.

Does Dilmah do green tea? Yes, Sri Lankan green tea, smaller production but distinctive.

What's the difference between Dilmah and Twinings Pure Ceylon? Dilmah is Sri Lankan owned, single origin, with a charitable foundation. Twinings Pure Ceylon is UK blended and a more commercial product.

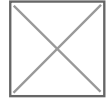
