

# Dragonfly Pure Rooibos: Organic South African

**Dragonfly Pure Rooibos is single ingredient organic South African red bush tea, naturally caffeine free, sweet woody, and one of the most versatile herbal infusions on the UK shelf.** Sourced from the Cederberg region of South Africa's Western Cape (the only place rooibos grows naturally), organic certified, and clean tasting enough to drink daily.

Rooibos (*Aspalathus linearis*) is a needle leaved shrub native exclusively to a small region of the Western Cape in South Africa. The leaves are harvested, oxidised (turning them from green to red, hence the Afrikaans name "rooibos" meaning "red bush"), dried, and packaged. The cup is naturally caffeine free, low in tannins, and rich in distinctive antioxidant compounds (notably aspalathin, which doesn't occur in any other plant).

Unlike most "tea" alternatives, rooibos genuinely has its own character, not just a herbal substitute for tea but a drink in its own right.

- **Pure rooibos.** Single ingredient, no flavourings, no additions.
- Organic certified, sourced from Cederberg region growers through Hampstead Tea's ethical supply chain.

## What it tastes like

Sweet, woody, naturally low bitter. The cup has a distinct red amber colour, a mild caramel vanilla aromatic, and a clean finish. No astringency. The sweetness is naturally occurring, many drinkers don't add sugar.

Rooibos doesn't taste like tea (*Camellia sinensis*), and that's the point. It's its own drink.

## How to brew

1. 1 tea bag per 200ml.
2. Just boiled water (~95°C), rooibos tolerates full boiling. Unlike [green tea](#), you cannot over extract bitter compounds.
3. Steep 5-7 minutes. Rooibos [benefits](#) from longer brewing.
4. Drink black, with a slice of lemon, with milk and honey, or as the base for a rooibos latte.

Rooibos is hard to ruin. Over steep it for 15 minutes and the cup is still drinkable.

## The aspalathin angle, in proportion

Aspalathin is a flavonoid unique to rooibos with antioxidant activity in the lab. You will see broader wellness claims attached to it, but the research is mostly in vitro or animal work and the dose in a cup of tea is modest. Rooibos is not a miracle drink: it is a pleasant, caffeine-free tea with a distinctive antioxidant profile, best enjoyed as exactly that rather than as a supplement.

## The South African context

Rooibos has been farmed commercially in South Africa since the early 1900s, but indigenous Khoisan peoples have used it for centuries before that. The Cederberg region's hot dry summers and cool wet

winters provide the specific conditions rooibos needs, attempts to grow it elsewhere have largely failed. The plant is genuinely terroir locked.

The South African rooibos industry employs thousands and represents a meaningful share of the Western Cape's agricultural economy. Buying organic, ethically sourced rooibos (Dragonfly, Hampstead, Clipper [Fairtrade](#)) supports the production model that pays workers fairly.

- **Evening drink.** Caffeine free, naturally sweet, ideal evening cup.
- **Pregnancy.** Generally considered safe; widely recommended as a tea substitute. [More on pregnancy and tea.](#)
- **Children.** Rooibos is widely considered child safe. Many South African families serve it to babies.
- **Iced tea base.** Cold brewed rooibos is excellent, sweet, smooth, refreshing. [More on cold brew.](#)
- **Latte base.** Rooibos latte (steamed milk + brewed rooibos + a touch of honey) is a genuine alternative to chai latte.
- **Cooking.** Rooibos poaching liquid for fruits; rooibos soaked dried fruits in baking; rooibos as a salt free flavour base in stocks.

- **Allergies.** Rooibos is in the legume family. Cross reactions with peanuts or other legumes are uncommon but possible.
- **Iron absorption.** Rooibos contains some tannins (much less than tea), but heavy daily consumption may modestly affect iron absorption, minor concern, mostly relevant for those with diagnosed iron deficiency.
- **Hormone sensitive conditions.** Some sources suggest rooibos has very mild oestrogenic activity. Discuss with GP if you have hormone sensitive conditions.

- **Dragonfly Pure Rooibos.** Organic, single ingredient. Mid premium tier.
- **Tetley Redbush.** Mainstream [supermarket](#) option. Comparable cup, lower price, sometimes lower grade leaf.
- **Clipper Pure Rooibos.** Organic, Fairtrade, plastic free bags. Direct competitor to Dragonfly at similar pricing.
- **Pukka Pure Rooibos.** Organic. Sometimes blended with other herbs in their range.
- **Specialist single estate rooibos.** From specific Cederberg growers. Premium tier.

## FAQ

**Is rooibos caffeine free?** Yes, completely. 0mg per cup.

**Does rooibos have [antioxidants](#)?** Yes, including the rooibos unique aspalathin. Modest antioxidant load at tea strength dosing.

**Can I drink rooibos while pregnant?** Yes, generally considered safe and widely recommended.

**How long should I steep rooibos?** 5-7 minutes for a proper cup. Hard to over steep.

**Best organic rooibos UK?** Dragonfly Pure Rooibos, Clipper Pure Rooibos, Pukka Rooibos, all organic, all good value.
