Good Earth Passionfruit & Orange is the tropical fruit caffeine free option in the brand's range, bright, sweet, summery, and one of the more vibrant fruit infusions on the UK shelf. Real fruit pieces, natural flavouring, no [caffeine](#). Excellent hot or iced; popular with kids; makes a beautiful summer mocktail base.

- [Hibiscus](#). Standard fruit tea base, provides colour and tartness.
- **Apple pieces**. Body and natural sweetness.
- **Orange peel**. Citrus aromatic.
- **Passionfruit pieces**. Real tropical fruit.
- **Natural orange and passionfruit [flavours](#)**. Reinforce the tropical character.
- **Possibly: rosehip, mango pieces**. Varies by batch.

What it tastes like

Vibrant orange pink cup. Tropical fruit aromatic, passionfruit forward, orange brightness, slight hibiscus tartness underneath. Naturally sweet without added sugar. Drinks beautifully cold over ice.

How to brew

1. 1 tea bag per 200ml.
2. Just boiled water (~95°C). Fruit infusions tolerate full boil.
3. Steep 5-7 minutes for full colour and flavour.
4. Drink hot, or cool over ice.
5. Optional: honey for added sweetness; sparkling water for a mocktail base.

- **Iced summer drink.** One of the best applications. [More on cold brew](#).
- **Children's hot drink.** Naturally sweet, fruity, no caffeine.
- **Mocktail base.** Brew strong, top with sparkling water, add lime and mint.
- **Pregnancy friendly fruit option.** Caffeine free; standard fruit tea ingredients are generally safe in moderation. [More on pregnancy and tea](#).
- **Late evening drinking.** Caffeine free; bright and refreshing.

The "real fruit pieces" question

Most mainstream fruit teas use a hibiscus + apple base for body and colour, with smaller amounts of "feature" fruit (passionfruit, mango, etc.) and natural flavour to amplify. This is normal industry practice. Real fruit pieces ARE in the bag, they're just augmented by natural flavouring for a stronger tropical character. Read the ingredients list: real fruit pieces should be among the top 5 ingredients.

- **Pregnancy.** Generally safe in moderation. Heavy daily hibiscus is sometimes cautioned in first trimester.
- **Allergies.** Tropical fruit allergies (passionfruit, mango) are uncommon but possible.
- **Tooth enamel.** Tart fruit teas can erode enamel with daily exposure. Drink and rinse with water.
- **Children.** Generally fine; introduce gradually.

FAQ

Is it caffeine free? Yes, completely.

Best for iced tea? Yes, vibrant tropical iced fruit tea, excellent in summer.

Pregnancy safe? Generally yes in moderation.

Has it got real fruit? Yes, real passionfruit and orange peel, augmented by natural flavouring.

Children's drink? Yes, naturally sweet, caffeine free.

Curator's note: this is the fruit tea I make in summer when iced fruit drinks would otherwise mean bottled juice or squash. Cold brewed for 6 hours, served over ice with a slice of lime, better than most commercial soft drinks. Lee, Teas.co.uk, Tunbridge Wells.

What's in the bag, at a glance

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Element	Role
Hibiscus	colour and tartness, the fruit tea base
Apple pieces	body and natural sweetness
Orange peel	citrus aromatic
Passionfruit pieces + natural flavour	the tropical feature note
Caffeine	0mg, completely caffeine free

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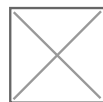
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
