**Hard water (UK South and East England) makes tea brew weaker, calcium and magnesium reduce extraction efficiency. Solutions: filtered water, [Yorkshire Tea Hard Water](#) blend (specifically engineered), bottled spring water for premium tea. The film on top is calcium tea polyphenol scum, cosmetic only.**

## What is hard water

Water with high mineral content (calcium and magnesium primarily). UK regions:

### Hard water (most of UK South / East)

London, South East, East Anglia, parts of Midlands.

### Soft water

North West, Scotland, Wales, parts of Yorkshire.

- Less efficient extraction.
- Cup looks slightly cloudy.

- Premium teas show less character.
- Mass market teas brew thinner.
- Visible film/scum on cup surface.

## Solutions

### Filtered water

Brita / Aqua Optima jug filters. Removes most calcium. Best single improvement.

### Yorkshire Tea Hard Water

Specifically engineered for hard water areas. Stronger blend compensates.

### Bottled spring water

For premium tea moments.

### Stronger brewing

Use 2 bags per cup; brew longer; squeeze firmly.

### Tetley Extra Strong

Designed for hard water regions.

Field	Detail
UK hard-water areas	SE England (London, Kent, Surrey, Sussex), East Anglia, Midlands; up to 300mg/L calcium carbonate
UK soft-water areas	Scotland, Wales, Cornwall, Devon, much of NW England; under 50mg/L
Effect on tea	Hard water produces "tea scum" on the surface, dulls flavour, gives black tea a flat character
Best fix	Filtered water (Brita or similar), bottled spring (low TDS, under 100mg/L), or boil-filter combo
Brand specific	Yorkshire Tea "For Hard Water" is reformulated to compensate; useful workaround in chalk regions

**FROM THE CURATOR** *teas* · Freshness beats provenance for most drinkers. Buy a smaller bag more often.
