

# Island Bakery Shortbread: The Universal Tea Companion

**Island Bakery Shortbread is the most universally tea pairable biscuit in our range, buttery, crumbly, simple, organic, made on the Isle of Mull. Pairs with literally every tea type.** The shortbread tradition runs deep in Scottish baking; this version honours it properly with high quality ingredients and small batch production.

Shortbread is the traditional Scottish butter biscuit, flour, butter, sugar, in roughly 3:2:1 ratio. The "short" in shortbread refers to the high fat content that produces the crumbly tender texture (the same "short" as in "shortcrust pastry"). Traditionally a luxury biscuit; now an everyday British classic.

Real shortbread has only three ingredients (plus a tiny pinch of salt). Anything with vanilla, eggs, leavening, or other additions is a shortbread variant rather than pure traditional shortbread.

- Organic Scottish flour

- Organic butter
- Organic sugar (golden caster typically)
- Pinch of salt

That's it. Made on the Isle of Mull. Small batch baked. The simplicity is the point, quality ingredients in classical proportions.

## What it tastes like

Buttery, sweet, crisp yet yielding. The "melt in mouth" texture is from the high butter content. The flavour is unfussy, butter, sugar, flour. Sometimes toasty top note from the bake. A simple, honest biscuit.

Shortbread is the most tea versatile biscuit. Works with:

- **Earl Grey.** The [bergamot](#) complements the buttery sweetness beautifully.
- **Yorkshire Tea / English Breakfast.** Classic British [afternoon](#) tea pairing.
- **Darjeeling.** The light muscatel character isn't overwhelmed.
- **Green tea.** The buttery contrast works surprisingly well with sencha.
- **White tea.** Both delicate; pairs gently.
- **Chai.** The spice complexity contrasts the simple biscuit.
- **Rooibos.** Sweet woody character + buttery shortbread.
- **Chamomile.** Evening pairing.
- **Coffee.** Yes, it works with coffee too.

If you can drink a tea, you can pair it with shortbread.

## Why shortbread works with everything

The simple butter sugar flour profile doesn't compete with any tea's character. Other biscuits (chocolate, ginger, lemon) have specific flavour profiles that work with some teas and clash with others. Shortbread's neutrality is its versatility.

## Cooking with shortbread

Beyond direct eating, shortbread makes:

- Cheesecake bases
- Trifle layers
- Crumble toppings
- Dessert garnish (alongside ice cream, sorbet)
- Ice cream sandwich shells

## Storage

Airtight tin or bag. Crisp texture preserved 3-4 weeks at room temperature (longer than most biscuits because of the simpler ingredient list). Beyond that, gradual softening, still drinkable but textural quality degrades.

## Allergens

- Wheat (gluten)
- Dairy (butter)

No eggs (traditional shortbread is egg free). No nuts. Check current packaging for cross contamination notices.

**How long does it keep?** 3-4 weeks airtight.

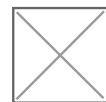
