Lipton's French market range, [Lipton Yellow Label](#) French Edition, Lipton Vert (green), and various French market [Earl Grey](#) variants, is genuinely different from UK Lipton, formulated for French tea drinking preferences (lighter, more aromatic, less robust). We import a small selection because UK resident French expats and curious British drinkers ask for it.

Major brands often produce different blends for different markets, formulating for local taste preferences:

- **Lipton UK:** Stronger, malty, milk friendly. Closer to PG Tips style.
- **Lipton France:** Lighter, more aromatic, less assertive. Closer to French preferences for tea drunk without milk.
- **Lipton Russia:** Different again, adapted for Russian tea drinking culture.
- **Lipton USA:** Different formulations for iced tea production.

The brand uses local sourcing partners and adjusts blend ratios for each market.

French market Lipton tends toward:

- Lighter Ceylon/green tea led blends
- More flavoured varieties (peach, jasmine, lemon)
- Less Assam content (French drinkers prefer lighter cups)
- Smaller pyramid bags or larger tea bag formats

Lipton Yellow Label French Edition

The French equivalent of UK "Lipton Yellow Label." Slightly lighter blend; the standard French daily tea bag option.

Lipton Vert ([Green Tea](#))

French market green tea. Lighter than UK [supermarket](#) green; designed for French style preparation (no milk, sometimes lemon).

Lipton Yellow Label Earl Grey (French)

French Earl Grey is generally lighter on [bergamot](#) than UK or US Earl Grey. The cup is more refined and less perfumed.

Lipton Mint Tea / Lipton Citron

French market flavoured options.

Lipton UK Yellow Label is a strong, malty, milk friendly cup. Lipton French Yellow Label is noticeably lighter, brighter, more drinkable black or with lemon. Same brand; different cups.

How to brew

1. 1 bag per 200ml.
2. Water at full rolling boil for black; 80-85°C for green.
3. Steep 3-4 minutes (slightly shorter than UK preference).
4. Drink black, with lemon, or with a small amount of milk (French preference is generally lighter on milk).

Caffeine

30-45mg per 200ml cup for black variants. Slightly lower than UK Lipton because of lighter blend.

French market Lipton requires specialist importers. Available through:

- French food specialty shops in UK cities
- Selected online tea importers
- Some Eurostar/airport French product shops

FAQ

Is Lipton French different from UK Lipton? Yes, different blend formulation for French market preferences (lighter, more aromatic).

Why do brands have different versions? Local taste preferences vary. Major brands adapt their products for different markets.

Where to buy in UK? French food specialty shops, online importers.

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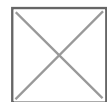
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
