

## Moroccan Mint Tea: The Atay Ritual

**Moroccan mint tea, in summary:** Moroccan mint tea (atay) is gunpowder green tea, fresh spearmint and sugar poured from height; a hospitality ritual built on three successive glasses.

Moroccan mint tea (atay bil naâna) is the defining drink of North Africa, [gunpowder green tea](#) brewed strong, fresh spearmint sprigs, generous sugar, poured from height into small glasses. The technique is part of the experience; the tradition has been refined over centuries.

### The traditional preparation

Authentic Moroccan mint tea uses:

- **Gunpowder green tea.** Chinese rolled green tea, the strength holds up to heavy sweetening.
- **Fresh spearmint sprigs.** Whole sprigs with leaves, not dried.
- **Lots of sugar.** Traditional preparation is heavily sweetened, 2-4 sugar cubes per small glass.
- **Boiling water.** Strong brewing.
- **Moroccan teapot.** Distinctive curved metal pot with long spout.
- **Small glass cups.** Tulip shaped or short narrow glasses.

### The traditional method

tea/

1. **Heat the teapot.** Pour boiling water into the metal pot; swirl; pour out.
2. **Add gunpowder green tea.** 1-2 heaped teaspoons per 250ml of finished tea.
3. **"Wash" the tea.** Pour boiling water over; swirl; pour off the first infusion (removes dust and "bitter" first extraction).
4. **Add fresh mint and sugar.** 4-6 fresh spearmint sprigs; 4-6 sugar cubes.
5. **Pour boiling water.** Fill the pot.
6. **Steep 5-7 minutes.** Sometimes the pot is placed back on a low flame.
7. **Pour from height.** Lift the pot 30cm above the glass. The high pour aerates the tea, creates foam, and cools it slightly.
8. **Serve in small glasses.** Drink while very hot, in small sips.

Moroccan mint tea is more than a drink, it's social ritual:

- **Hospitality.** Offered to all guests.
- **Three glass tradition.** Tea is poured three times. The saying: "the first glass is bitter as life, the second strong as love, the third gentle as death." Each glass is the same brew at progressive infusions.
- **Family gatherings.** Daily ritual after meals.
- **Negotiation and meeting.** Business and social discussions traditionally accompany tea.

## Why gunpowder green tea

The Moroccan mint tradition adopted Chinese gunpowder green tea via 18th-19th century European trade routes. Gunpowder works because:

- Strong enough to stand up to heavy sweetening
- Tightly rolled pellets brew slowly during the long steep
- Multiple infusions possible (the three glass tradition)
- Affordable for daily consumption at scale

You can make reasonable Moroccan style mint tea at home in the UK:

### Easy method (using bags)

1. 1 bag gunpowder green tea + 1 bag spearmint (or Pukka Three Mint) per 200ml.
2. Just boiled water (~95°C).
3. Steep 4-5 minutes.
4. Add 1-2 sugar cubes.
5. Stir; drink.

### Pre blended Moroccan mint tea bags

- **Dragonfly Moroccan Mint.** Organic gunpowder + mint. [More here](#).
- **Twinings Moroccan Mint.** Mainstream UK option.
- **Good Earth Moroccan Mint Green.** Budget alternative.

### Full traditional method (best result)

Use the eight step method above. Loose leaf gunpowder + fresh spearmint + sugar. Genuinely transformative experience.

### Why pour from height?

The high pour serves multiple purposes:

- Aerates the tea (creates foam, desirable in Moroccan tradition)
- Cools the tea slightly during pour (prevents burning the lips)
- Mixes the multi glass progression evenly
- Visual ceremony, part of the host's display of skill

### Buying for traditional preparation

- **Loose gunpowder green tea.** Specialist Chinese tea retailers, Asian groceries, Moroccan / Middle Eastern food shops.
- **Fresh spearmint.** Greengrocer / [supermarket](#). Or grow your own (mint is invasive, easy to keep going).

- **Sugar cubes.** Standard.
- **Moroccan teapot (optional).** Specialist Moroccan/Middle Eastern shops or online imports. £15-50.
- **Tea glasses.** Small short glasses or specifically Moroccan tulip shaped tea glasses.

## Caffeine

30-40mg per 200ml cup from the gunpowder green tea base.

- **After Moroccan / Middle Eastern meals.** The traditional context.
- **Hospitality / entertaining.** Distinctive drink for guests.
- **Iced summer drinking.** Heavily sweetened iced Moroccan style is excellent in summer.
- **Mid afternoon refresh.** Mint cooling + moderate caffeine lift.

- **Sugar content.** Traditional preparation is very sweet, adapt to preference.
- **Caffeine.** Moderate green tea caffeine; multiple cups daily within sensible limits.
- **Reflux.** Mint can trigger reflux in some.
- **Pregnancy.** Within NHS caffeine limits is fine.

## FAQ

**What is Moroccan mint tea?** Gunpowder green tea brewed strong with fresh spearmint and heavy sugar. The traditional drink of North Africa.

**Why pour from height?** Aerates the tea, creates foam, cools slightly, displays ceremony.

**How sweet should it be?** Traditional preparation is very sweet (4-6 sugars per pot). Modern UK preference may use less.

**Caffeinated?** Yes, 30-40mg per cup.

**Best brand UK?** Dragonfly Moroccan Mint for organic; specialist loose gunpowder + fresh mint for traditional preparation.

*Curator's note: making proper Moroccan mint tea, pouring from height, sweet enough to make British dentists wince, is genuinely transformative. The combination of gunpowder green's body, fresh spearmint,*

Element	The note
Tea base	Chinese gunpowder green tea, robust and slightly smoky
Mint	Fresh Moroccan spearmint (naâna), generous handful
Sugar	Substantial, traditional; "atay" without sugar is not the drink
Vessel	Berrad teapot, slim ornate glasses
Method	Boiled briefly, poured from height for foam
Number of glasses	Three; first strong, second balanced, third sweet
Hospitality	Centre of welcome; refusing reads as social rejection
UK approximation	Gunpowder + fresh mint + modest sugar + glass cup

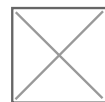
