

PG Tips Gold Special Blend Review

PG Tips Gold, in summary: PG Tips Gold is the premium tier of the range: stronger CTC blend, richer maltier cup, pyramid bag, 30-50% above standard PG Tips; rivals Yorkshire Gold.

[PG Tips Gold Special Blend](#) is PG's premium variant, slightly more refined blend than PG Tips Original, positioned to compete with [Yorkshire](#) Gold and [Twinings](#) premium options. Modest step up; modest price premium.

A slightly more premium [black tea](#) blend within the PG Tips brand family:

- Higher quality leaf grading than PG Tips Original
- Distinct gold themed packaging
- Marginally more refined cup character
- ~10-15% more expensive than PG Tips Original

What's in the bag

- Premium tier Assam, Kenyan, and Sri Lankan tea blend

- CTC processing (same as PG Tips Original)
- Slightly higher proportion of premium grade leaves
- Fewer fannings (smaller broken pieces)

What it tastes like

Recognisably PG Tips character, strong, malty, milk friendly, but slightly cleaner and more refined than PG Tips Original. The difference is subtle for casual drinkers; noticeable for those familiar with both.

How to brew

1. 1 bag per 200ml.
2. Water at full rolling boil.
3. Steep 4 minutes.
4. Add milk and sugar to taste.

How it compares to competitors

vs PG Tips Original

Cleaner, slightly more refined cup. Marginal improvement in flavour structure. Worth the 10-15% premium for those who notice the difference.

vs Yorkshire Gold

Yorkshire Gold is the more famous premium UK black tea. Comparable tier; slightly different blend character. Yorkshire Gold leans more Assam malty; PG Tips Gold sits somewhere between.

vs Twinings [English Breakfast](#)

Twinings is more refined, slightly lighter cup. PG Tips Gold is closer to PG Tips' robust character but elevated.

vs Specialist single origin (Hyson Premium Breakfast, Dilmah)

Specialist single origin teas offer cleaner provenance and often better cup character at similar pricing. PG Tips Gold is mid tier convenience.

Caffeine

50-55mg per 200ml cup. Slightly higher than standard PG Tips because of higher leaf quality.

Use cases

- **PG Tips Original drinkers wanting a step up.** Familiar brand; better cup.
- **Daily premium drinking.** Step up from [supermarket](#) basics.
- **Office tea round upgrade.** When standard PG Tips feels too basic.
- **Visitor tea.** Slightly more refined for guests.

The verdict

PG Tips Gold is a reasonable mid tier upgrade from PG Tips Original. Whether it justifies its premium over Yorkshire Tea Original (which costs about the same) comes down to brand preference. Yorkshire Tea Original is the more universally loved British black tea blend; PG Tips Gold is the PG family's premium offering.

For genuine cup quality upgrade, specialist single origin Ceylon or Hyson Premium Breakfast offers better value than PG Tips Gold. [More on Hyson](#).

Buying

Mainstream UK supermarkets carry PG Tips Gold. Roughly £4-5 per 80 bags vs ~£3-4 for PG Tips Original.

Cautions

- **Caffeine sensitivity.** Slightly higher than standard PG Tips.
- **Iron absorption.** Tannins; drink between meals.
- **Pregnancy.** Within NHS caffeine limits is fine.

FAQ

Is PG Tips Gold worth the premium? Modestly. Subtle cup quality improvement; not transformative.

How does it compare to Yorkshire Gold? Comparable tier. Yorkshire Gold leans Assam malty; PG Tips Gold is more balanced. Brand preference rules.

Caffeine? 50-55mg per cup, slightly higher than PG Tips Original.

Best use case? Daily premium drinker upgrading from PG Tips Original.

Better than supermarket own brand? Yes, meaningful improvement over budget supermarket EB.

Curator's note: PG Tips Gold is a reasonable mid tier blend. Whether it's better than Yorkshire Gold comes down to taste preference. For real cup quality upgrade at similar price, single estate Ceylon (Hyson) offers better value. Lee, Teas.co.uk, Tunbridge Wells.

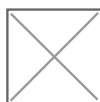

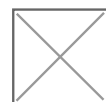
