Scottish Blend, in summary: Scottish Blend is the Scottish-water-matched mass-market builder tea brand, blended for the soft-water conditions of Scotland; bolder than Yorkshire.

Scottish Blend Tea (sometimes "Scottish [Breakfast](#)") is the dedicated tea category for Scotland's soft water, different blend ratios designed to brew well where mineral content is low. PG Tips Scottish Blend, Williamson Scottish Blend, Brodies Scottish Breakfast all serve this market.

The water hardness factor

Scotland (especially the Highlands and the West) has predominantly soft water, low mineral content. England (especially the South East and Midlands) has predominantly hard water, high mineral content.

The same tea brewed in different waters produces very different cups:

- **Hard water:** Strong tea blends needed; minerals can dull tea flavour.
- **Soft water:** Lighter blends preferred; standard strong blends can taste sharp or astringent.

Most British tea brands use one blend for all UK water conditions. PG Tips, [Yorkshire](#), and others making water specific variants reflects:

- Real water condition cup quality differences
- Brand loyalty marketing (Scottish drinkers wanting Scottish blend)
- Volume sufficient to justify separate production

Smoother, less astringent than standard mainstream British blends when brewed in soft water. The reformulated blend has:

- Less Assam (which can taste sharp in soft water)
- More Ceylon and Indonesian origin tea
- Slightly lighter overall character

In hard water, Scottish Blend tastes thin and weak. In soft water, it shines.

How to brew

1. 1 bag per 200ml.
2. Water at full rolling boil.
3. Steep 3-4 minutes (slightly shorter than standard PG Tips).

4. Add milk and sugar to taste.

- Scotland (especially West Highlands, Glasgow, Edinburgh)
- North West England (parts of Cumbria, Lake District)
- Parts of Wales (especially North Wales)
- Some areas of Northern England with soft water

- Hard water England (London, South East, Midlands)
- Hard water areas anywhere

In hard water, choose [Yorkshire Tea Hard Water](#) or standard PG Tips instead.

Caffeine

40-50mg per 200ml cup. Standard British [black tea](#) range.

The Scottish tea heritage

Scotland has its own tea traditions:

- Strong morning tea drinking with milk and sugar
- "Tea time" social ritual
- Robert Drysdale's 1840s Scottish tea tasting heritage
- Edinburgh based premium tea brands (Brodies, Eteaket)

Scottish tea identity is distinct enough to support its own market.

Scottish Blend products primarily distributed in Scottish supermarkets. Available across UK via online retailers. Limited mainstream distribution in England.

FAQ

What is Scottish Blend Tea? Tea reformulated for Scottish soft water brewing.

Should I buy it in England? Generally no, designed for soft water. In hard water England, standard PG Tips or Yorkshire Tea Hard Water are better.

Caffeine? 40-50mg per cup.

Best for whom? Scottish drinkers in soft water regions; soft water English regions.

Why does water hardness matter? Mineral content affects how tea compounds extract and present in the cup.

Curator's note: Scottish Blend is a niche product solving a real problem. Most British drinkers don't realise water hardness affects their tea cup; if you've moved between regions and noticed your tea tastes "different," water is usually why. Choose the blend for your water. Lee, Teas.co.uk, Tunbridge Wells.
